
### Architect as a Noun

- A person who is responsible for inventing or realizing a particular idea or project.






## Synonyms of "Architect" as a noun (14 Words)

<u>designer</u>	Someone who specializes in graphic design. A fashion <b>designer</b> .
draughtsman	A person who makes detailed technical plans or drawings.
father	A male parent also used as a term of address to your father. <i>Keep the faith of our fore</i> <b>father</b> s.



<u>founder</u>	A person who manufactures articles of cast metal; the owner or operator of a foundry. <i>An iron <b>founder</b></i> .
founding father	Food and lodging provided in addition to money.
instigator	A person who initiates a course of action. Any <b>instigator</b> s of violence will be punished.
<u>mother</u>	A woman who has given birth to a child also used as a term of address to your mother. A <b>mother</b> of three.
originator	Someone who creates new things. Wegener was the <b>originator</b> of the theory of continental drift.
planner	A list or chart with information that is an aid to planning. <i>Economic <b>planner</b>s.</i>
prime mover	The second canonical hour; about 6 a.m.

lithograph	Print by lithography. He <b>lithograph</b> ed the diploma leaving only two blanks one for the name of the recipient and the other for the date.
modernist	An artist who makes a deliberate break with previous styles. James Joyce and other 20th century <b>modernist</b> s.
muralist	A painter of murals.
painter	Large American feline resembling a lion. A self employed <b>painter</b> and decorator.
panther	A leopard, especially a black one.
<u>portrait</u>	A representation or impression of someone or something in language or on film or television. A <b>portrait</b> of George III.
<u>rebuild</u>	An instance of rebuilding. The Trust have recognized the hard work of all who were involved in this daunting <b>rebuild</b> .
recast	Cast again, in a different role. <i>He was <b>recast</b> as Iago.</i>
reconstruct	Cause somebody to adapt or reform socially or politically. Later emperors <b>reconstruct</b> ed the army.
redesign	The action or process of redesigning something. It was achieved by the <b>redesign</b> of the product.



remodel	Cast or model anew. The station was <b>remodel</b> led and enlarged in 1927.
reshape	Shape again or shape differently. The new foreign minister <b>reshape</b> d the foreign policy of his country.
<u>schematic</u>	In technical contexts a schematic diagram in particular of an electric or electronic circuit. Only a few manufacturers provide <b>schematic</b> s with their gear.
sculptor	An artist who creates sculptures.
silversmith	Someone who makes or repairs articles of silver.
smith	Someone who works at something specified. <i>Tin bronze was cast into ingots before being <b>smith</b>ed into bracelets.</i>
tanner	A lotion or cream designed to promote the development of a suntan or produce a similar skin colour artificially. <i>Skincare companies are coming to the rescue of consumers with sunless</i> <i>tanners</i> .
