<u>blacksmith</u>	A smith who forges and shapes iron with a hammer and anvil.
<u>blueprint</u>	Make a blueprint of. A blueprint for a house.
bricklayer	A person whose job is to build walls, houses, and other structures with bricks.
<u>builder</u>	A person who constructs something by putting parts or material together. <i>Empire builder</i> .
carpentry	The work made or done by a carpenter. The superb carpentry of the timber roof.
chiaroscuro	A monochrome picture made by using several different shades of the same color. The chiaroscuro of cobbled streets.



conception	An abstract idea; a concept. An unfertilized egg before conception .
design	Create the design for create or execute in an artistic or highly skilled manner. She design ed a good excuse for not attending classes that day.
<u>drawing</u>	The art or activity of making drawings. The drawing of water from the well.
fashion	Consumer goods (especially clothing) in the current mode. The latest Parisian fashion s.
<u>gothic</u>	Characteristic of the style of type commonly used for printing German. <i>Gothic</i> novels like Frankenstein.
lighting	Apparatus for supplying artificial light effects for the stage or a film. <i>Fluorescent bulbs for street lighting.</i>
mason	A Freemason. The chief mason at Westminster Abbey.
<u>mode</u>	A classification of propositions on the basis of whether they claim necessity or possibility or impossibility. <i>His preferred</i> mode of travel was a kayak.
modernist	Of or associated with modernism, especially in the arts. <i>His early work explored all manner of modernist styles.</i>
redesign	The action or process of redesigning something. It was achieved by the redesign of the product.
remodel	Do over, as of (part of) a house. She remodel led the head with careful fingers.
<u>schematic</u>	In technical contexts a schematic diagram in particular of an electric or electronic circuit. Only a few manufacturers provide schematic s with their gear.
silversmith	Someone who makes or repairs articles of silver.
smith	Someone who works metal (especially by hammering it when it is hot and malleable. The wheels then needed the smith s attention.
<u>spire</u>	A long tapering object. <i>Spire</i> s of delphiniums.
style	Make consistent with a certain fashion or style. The 1920s had a style of their own.



tanner	A craftsman who tans skins and hides. <i>Skincare companies are coming to the rescue of consumers with sunless</i> <i>tanners</i> .
<u>vogue</u>	Dance to music in such a way as to imitate the characteristic poses struck by a model on a catwalk. <i>Leather is the latest vogue</i> .
woodwork	The wooden parts of a room or building, such as window frames or doors. <i>The woodwork was painted blue</i> .
workshop	A meeting at which a group of people engage in intensive discussion and activity on a particular subject or project. The play was workshop ped briefly at the Shaw Festival.
