Synonyms of "Arguably" as an adverb (8 Words)

conceivably It is conceivable or imaginable that.

It may **conceivably** cause liver disease.

In a way that possible or practical to do or achieve.

feasibly I ve learned a huge amount about what I could **feasibly** achieve in my next

race.

maybe Perhaps; possibly.

Maybe I won t go back.

Used when one does not wish to be too definite or assertive in the expression

perhaps of an opinion.

Perhaps I should have been frank with him.

In a way that seems reasonable or probable.

plausibly

Both candidates can plausibly claim victory is within their reach.



Used to emphasize that one feels that something is surprising, or bewildering. possibly

Could you **possibly** pour me another cup of tea.

With a possibility of becoming actual. potentially

A potentially dangerous situation.

With considerable certainty; without much doubt. **probably**

She would **probably** never see him again.
