Definitions of "Arguably" as an adverb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “arguably” as an adverb can have the following definitions:

- *It may be argued (used to qualify the statement of an opinion or belief).*
- *As can be shown by argument.*

Synonyms of "Arguably" as an adverb (8 Words)

conceivably	It is conceivable or imaginable that. <i>It may conceivably cause liver disease.</i>
feasibly	In a way that possible or practical to do or achieve. <i>I ve learned a huge amount about what I could feasibly achieve in my next race.</i>
maybe	Perhaps; possibly. <i>Maybe I won t go back.</i>
perhaps	Used when one does not wish to be too definite or assertive in the expression of an opinion. <i>Perhaps I should have been frank with him.</i>
plausibly	In a way that seems reasonable or probable. <i>Both candidates can plausibly claim victory is within their reach.</i>

- possibly** Used to emphasize that one feels that something is surprising, or bewildering.
*Could you **possibly** pour me another cup of tea.*
- potentially** With a possibility of becoming actual.
*A **potentially** dangerous situation.*
- probably** With considerable certainty; without much doubt.
*She would **probably** never see him again.*

Usage Examples of "Arguably" as an adverb

- *She is arguably the greatest woman tennis player of all time.*
