Definitions of "Ark" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “ark” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A ship or boat.*
- *A low hut used to house livestock, often incorporating a covered run.*
- *(in the Bible) the ship built by Noah to save his family and two of every kind of animal from the Flood; Noah's ark.*
- *Sacred chest where the ancient Hebrews kept the two tablets containing the Ten Commandments.*
- *A boat built by Noah to save his family and animals from the flood.*
- *A chest or cupboard housing the Torah scrolls in a synagogue.*
- *(Judaism) sacred chest where the ancient Hebrews kept the two tablets containing the Ten Commandments.*
- *A small bivalve mollusc which attaches itself to rocks with byssus threads.*



Synonyms of "Ark" as a noun (12 Words)

accommodation	In the theories of Jean Piaget: the modification of internal representations in order to accommodate a changing knowledge of reality. <i>There was lifeboat accommodation for 1 178 people.</i>
ark of the covenant	An agreement between God and his people in which God makes certain promises and requires certain behavior from them in return.
haven	A place of safety or refuge. <i>A haven for wildlife.</i>
home	The district or country where one was born or has settled on a long-term basis. <i>There s no place like home.</i>
housing	Structures collectively in which people are housed. <i>A housing development.</i>
place of safety	The particular portion of space occupied by something.
place of shelter	Proper or designated social situation.

refuge	Something or someone turned to for assistance or security. <i>He was forced to take refuge in the French embassy.</i>
safe haven	A ventilated or refrigerated cupboard for securing provisions from pests.
safe house	Strongbox where valuables can be safely kept.
sanctuary	A holy place; a temple. <i>A donkey sanctuary.</i>
sanctum	A private place from which most people are excluded. <i>He withdrew to his sanctum sanctorum where the children could never go.</i>



Usage Examples of "Ark" as a noun

- *Poultry arks make useful supervised runs for guinea pigs.*
