- A ship or boat.
- A low hut used to house livestock, often incorporating a covered run.
- (in the Bible) the ship built by Noah to save his family and two of every kind of animal from the Flood; Noah's ark.
- Sacred chest where the ancient Hebrews kept the two tablets containing the Ten Commandments.
- A boat built by Noah to save his family and animals from the flood.
- A chest or cupboard housing the Torah scrolls in a synagogue.
- (Judaism) sacred chest where the ancient Hebrews kept the two tablets containing the Ten Commandments.
- A small bivalve mollusc which attaches itself to rocks with byssus threads.

pests.


safe house Strongbox where valuables can be safely kept.
