- *A subtle, pervasive quality or atmosphere.*

- bouquet** An arrangement of flowers that is usually given as a present.
*We will happily publish the **bouquets** and brickbats.*
- fragrance** A distinctive odor that is pleasant.
*Our fine selection of classic **fragrances** for men and women.*
- nose** A front that resembles a human nose especially the front of an aircraft.
*The wine has a raspberry **nose** and a clean taste.*
- odor** The sensation that results when olfactory receptors in the nose are stimulated by particular chemicals in gaseous form.
- odour** Any property detected by the olfactory system.
*An **odour** of suspicion.*
- perfume** A toiletry that emits and diffuses a fragrant odor.
*Musk based **perfumes**.*
- redolence** A pleasingly sweet olfactory property.

savour	The taste experience when a savoury condiment is taken into the mouth. <i>The subtle savour of wood smoke.</i>
scent	A trail indicated by the characteristic smell of an animal and perceptible to hounds or other animals. <i>She sprayed scent over her body.</i>
smell	A quality in something that is perceived by the faculty of smell an odour or scent. <i>A highly developed sense of smell.</i>
tang	A tart spicy quality. <i>The clean salty tang of the sea.</i>
whiff	An unpleasant smell. <i>I caught a whiff of eau de cologne.</i>

ambrosial	Extremely pleasing to the taste; sweet and fragrant. <i>Ambrosial food.</i>
<u>aromatic</u>	An aromatic compound. <i>A massage with aromatic oils.</i>
<u>bouquet</u>	An attractively arranged bunch of flowers, especially one presented as a gift or carried at a ceremony. <i>We will happily publish the bouquets and brickbats.</i>
cloying	Overly sweet. <i>A romantic rather cloying story.</i>
delicious	Delightful. <i>A delicious joke.</i>
enrage	Make (someone) very angry. <i>The students were enraged at these new rules.</i>

exasperate	Exasperate or irritate. <i>This futile process exasperates prison officers.</i>
flavorful	Full of flavor.
floral	A fabric with a floral design. <i>Faunal and floral evolution.</i>
flowery	Smelling of flowers. <i>Flowery wallpaper.</i>
fragrance	A pleasant, sweet smell. <i>Our fine selection of classic fragrances for men and women.</i>
fragrant	Having a pleasant or sweet smell. <i>She gathered the fragrant blooms.</i>
frankincense	An aromatic gum resin obtained from various Arabian or East African trees; formerly valued for worship and for embalming and fumigation.
incense	The pleasing scent produced when incense is burned. <i>Incense filled the room.</i>
infuriate	Make furious. <i>I was infuriated by your article.</i>
musk	An odorous glandular secretion from the male musk deer used as a perfume fixative.
musky	Having a smell or taste like that of musk.
nectary	A nectar-secreting glandular organ in a flower (floral) or on a leaf or stem (extrafloral).
odor	The sensation that results when olfactory receptors in the nose are stimulated by particular chemicals in gaseous form.
odoriferous	Having or giving off a smell, especially an unpleasant one. <i>An odoriferous pile of fish.</i>
odorous	Having or giving off an odour. <i>Fresh odorous bread.</i>
perfume	Apply perfume to. <i>The cream is perfumed with rosemary and iris extracts.</i>
redolent	Serving to bring to mind. <i>A rich inky redolent wine.</i>
saccharine	Excessively sweet or sentimental. <i>Saccharine music.</i>
sandalwood	A perfume or incense derived from the sandalwood.
scent	Sniff the air for a scent. <i>The Premier scented victory last night.</i>

sweet

With sweetening added.

*A very **sweet** nurse came along.*

tasty

Pleasing to the sense of taste.

*A **tasty** profit margin of 42.*

zesty

Having an agreeably pungent taste.
