- *A distinctive, typically pleasant smell.*
- *Any property detected by the olfactory system.*
- *A distinctive odor that is pleasant.*
- *A subtle, pervasive quality or atmosphere.*



## Synonyms of "Aroma" as a noun (12 Words)

- bouquet** An arrangement of flowers that is usually given as a present.  
*We will happily publish the **bouquets** and brickbats.*
- fragrance** A distinctive odor that is pleasant.  
*Our fine selection of classic **fragrances** for men and women.*
- nose** A front that resembles a human nose especially the front of an aircraft.  
*The wine has a raspberry **nose** and a clean taste.*
- odor** The sensation that results when olfactory receptors in the nose are stimulated by particular chemicals in gaseous form.
- odour** Any property detected by the olfactory system.  
*An **odour** of suspicion.*
- perfume** A toiletry that emits and diffuses a fragrant odor.  
*Musk based **perfumes**.*
- redolence** A pleasingly sweet olfactory property.

- savour** The taste experience when a savoury condiment is taken into the mouth.  
*The subtle **savour** of wood smoke.*
- scent** A trail indicated by the characteristic smell of an animal and perceptible to hounds or other animals.  
*She sprayed **scent** over her body.*
- smell** A quality in something that is perceived by the faculty of smell an odour or scent.  
*A highly developed sense of **smell**.*
- tang** A tart spicy quality.  
*The clean salty **tang** of the sea.*
- whiff** An unpleasant smell.  
*I caught a **whiff** of eau de cologne.*

<b>ambrosial</b>	Extremely pleasing to the taste; sweet and fragrant. <i>Ambrosial</i> food.
<b><u>aromatic</u></b>	An aromatic compound. A massage with <i>aromatic</i> oils.
<b><u>bouquet</u></b>	An attractively arranged bunch of flowers, especially one presented as a gift or carried at a ceremony. We will happily publish the <i>bouquets</i> and brickbats.
<b>claying</b>	Overly sweet. A romantic rather <i>claying</i> story.
<b>delicious</b>	Delightful. A <i>delicious</i> joke.
<b>enrage</b>	Make (someone) very angry. The students were <i>enraged</i> at these new rules.

<b>exasperate</b>	Exasperate or irritate. <i>This futile process <b>exasperates</b> prison officers.</i>
<b>flavorful</b>	Full of flavor.
<b>floral</b>	A fabric with a floral design. <i>Faunal and <b>floral</b> evolution.</i>
<b>flowery</b>	Smelling of flowers. <i><b>Flowery</b> wallpaper.</i>
<b>fragrance</b>	A pleasant, sweet smell. <i>Our fine selection of classic <b>fragrances</b> for men and women.</i>
<b>fragrant</b>	Having a pleasant or sweet smell. <i>She gathered the <b>fragrant</b> blooms.</i>
<b>frankincense</b>	An aromatic gum resin obtained from various Arabian or East African trees; formerly valued for worship and for embalming and fumigation.
<b>incense</b>	The pleasing scent produced when incense is burned. <i><b>Incense</b> filled the room.</i>
<b>infuriate</b>	Make furious. <i>I was <b>infuriated</b> by your article.</i>
<b>musk</b>	An odorous glandular secretion from the male musk deer used as a perfume fixative.
<b>musky</b>	Having a smell or taste like that of musk.
<b>nectary</b>	A nectar-secreting glandular organ in a flower (floral) or on a leaf or stem (extrafloral).
<b>odor</b>	The sensation that results when olfactory receptors in the nose are stimulated by particular chemicals in gaseous form.
<b>odoriferous</b>	Having or giving off a smell, especially an unpleasant one. <i>An <b>odoriferous</b> pile of fish.</i>
<b>odorous</b>	Having or giving off an odour. <i>Fresh <b>odorous</b> bread.</i>
<b>perfume</b>	Apply perfume to. <i>The cream is <b>perfumed</b> with rosemary and iris extracts.</i>
<b>redolent</b>	Serving to bring to mind. <i>A rich inky <b>redolent</b> wine.</i>
<b>saccharine</b>	Excessively sweet or sentimental. <i><b>Saccharine</b> music.</i>
<b>sandalwood</b>	A perfume or incense derived from the sandalwood.
<b>scent</b>	Sniff the air for a scent. <i>The Premier <b>scented</b> victory last night.</i>

<b>smell</b>	Smell bad. <i>It had the <b>smell</b> of treason.</i>
<b><u>sweet</u></b>	With sweetening added. <i>A very <b>sweet</b> nurse came along.</i>
<b><u>tasty</u></b>	Pleasing to the sense of taste. <i>A <b>tasty</b> profit margin of 42.</i>
<b>zesty</b>	Having an agreeably pungent taste.
