# **Conjugate Arrange**

#### Arrange in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>arrange</b>	We <b>arrange</b>
You <b>arrange</b>	You <b>arrange</b>
He/She/It arranges	They <b>arrange</b>

# Arrange in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am arranging	We <b>are arranging</b>
You <b>are arranging</b>	You <b>are arranging</b>
He/She/It is arranging	They are arranging

# **Arrange in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have arranged	We have arranged
You <b>have arranged</b>	You have arranged
He/She/It has arranged	They have arranged

# **Arrange in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been arranging	We have been arranging
You have been arranging	You have been arranging
He/She/It has been arranging	They have been arranging

# Arrange in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I arranged	We <b>arranged</b>
You <b>arranged</b>	You <b>arranged</b>
He/She/It arranged	They <b>arranged</b>

#### Arrange in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was arranging	We were arranging
You <b>were arranging</b>	You were arranging
He/She/It was arranging	They were arranging

# **Arrange in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had arranged	We had arranged
You <b>had arranged</b>	You had arranged
He/She/It had arranged	They had arranged

# **Arrange in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been arranging	We had been arranging
You <b>had been arranging</b>	You had been arranging
He/She/It had been arranging	They had been arranging

# Arrange in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will arrange	We <b>will arrange</b>
You <b>will arrange</b>	You <b>will arrange</b>
He/She/It will arrange	They will arrange

# Arrange in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be arranging	We <b>will be arranging</b>
You <b>will be arranging</b>	You <b>will be arranging</b>
He/She/It will be arranging	They will be arranging

# **Arrange in Future Perfect Tense**

# **Arrange in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been arranging	We <b>will have been arranging</b>
You <b>will have been arranging</b>	You <b>will have been arranging</b>
He/She/It will have been arranging	They will have been arranging
