Associations of "Art piece" (30 Words)

apportion	Give out as one’s portion or share. <i>Voting power will be apportioned according to contribution.</i>
artist	A person who practises or performs any of the creative arts, such as a sculptor, film-maker, actor, or dancer. <i>Rip off artists.</i>
artistic	Aesthetically pleasing. <i>A denial of artistic freedom.</i>
ballet	A creative work or performance of ballet or the music written for it. <i>The Bolshoi Ballet.</i>
ballroom	Ballroom dancing. <i>The number of people learning ballroom has doubled in the last two years.</i>
carve	Establish (a career, role, or reputation) for oneself through hard work. <i>The company has carved a name for itself in the smartphone market.</i>
choreographer	A person who composes the sequence of steps and moves for a performance of dance. <i>A professional choreographer.</i>
choreography	The representation of dancing by symbols as music is represented by notes. <i>The rumbustious choreography reflects the themes of the original play.</i>
cinematic	Having qualities characteristic of films. <i>The cinematic feel of their video.</i>
clipping	The act of clipping or snipping. <i>Hedge clippings and grass cuttings.</i>
cutting	The action of cutting something. <i>The cutting blades of the hedge trimmer.</i>
etch	The action or process of etching something. <i>The events remain etched in the minds of all who witnessed them.</i>

fresco	The method of painting frescoes used in Roman times and by the great masters of the Italian Renaissance including Giotto Raphael and Michelangelo. <i>Four scenes had been frescoed on the wall.</i>
gouache	A picture painted using the gouache method.
graffiti	Write or draw graffiti on something. <i>He and another artist graffitied an entire train.</i>
graph	Plot upon a graph.
jigsaw	A machine saw with a fine blade enabling it to cut curved lines in a sheet of wood, metal, or plastic. <i>Time is passed by doing jigsaws.</i>
minstrel	Celebrate by singing in the style of minstrels. <i>The exaggerated dialect of blackface minstrels.</i>
moiety	Each of two social or ritual groups into which a people is divided, especially among Australian Aboriginal people and some North American Indians. <i>The enzyme removes the sulphate moiety.</i>
painting	The occupation of a house painter. <i>House painting was the only craft he knew.</i>
partition	The act of dividing or partitioning separation by the creation of a boundary that divides or keeps apart. <i>This takes a copy of hard disk partition information during installation.</i>
photography	The process of producing images of objects on photosensitive surfaces.
picture	Show in or as in a picture. <i>His pictures hang in the Louvre.</i>
sculptor	An artist who makes sculptures.
seascape	A depiction of a seascape.
shard	A piece of broken ceramic, metal, glass, or rock, typically having sharp edges. <i>Shards of glass flew in all directions.</i>
snip	The act of clipping or snipping. <i>She was snipping a few dead heads off the roses.</i>
snippet	A small piece of anything (especially a piece that has been snipped off). <i>Snippets of information about the war.</i>
sunder	Break apart or in two, using violence. <i>A universe sundered ages ago in a divine war.</i>

trptych

A picture or relief carving on three panels, typically hinged together vertically and used as an altarpiece.

A **trptych** on the theme of the holocaust.
