## Associations of "Art piece" (30 Words)

<a href="#">apportion</a>	Give out as one’s portion or share. <i>Voting power will be <b>apportioned</b> according to contribution.</i>
<b>artist</b>	A person who practises or performs any of the creative arts, such as a sculptor, film-maker, actor, or dancer. <i>Rip off <b>artists</b>.</i>
<a href="#">artistic</a>	Aesthetically pleasing. <i>A denial of <b>artistic</b> freedom.</i>
<b>ballet</b>	A creative work or performance of ballet or the music written for it. <i>The Bolshoi <b>Ballet</b>.</i>
<a href="#">ballroom</a>	Ballroom dancing. <i>The number of people learning <b>ballroom</b> has doubled in the last two years.</i>
<a href="#">carve</a>	Establish (a career, role, or reputation) for oneself through hard work. <i>The company has <b>carved</b> a name for itself in the smartphone market.</i>
<b>choreographer</b>	A person who composes the sequence of steps and moves for a performance of dance. <i>A professional <b>choreographer</b>.</i>
<a href="#">choreography</a>	The representation of dancing by symbols as music is represented by notes. <i>The rumbustious <b>choreography</b> reflects the themes of the original play.</i>
<b>cinematic</b>	Having qualities characteristic of films. <i>The <b>cinematic</b> feel of their video.</i>
<b>clipping</b>	The act of clipping or snipping. <i>Hedge <b>clippings</b> and grass cuttings.</i>
<b>cutting</b>	The action of cutting something. <i>The <b>cutting</b> blades of the hedge trimmer.</i>
<b>etch</b>	The action or process of etching something. <i>The events remain <b>etched</b> in the minds of all who witnessed them.</i>

<b>fresco</b>	The method of painting frescoes used in Roman times and by the great masters of the Italian Renaissance including Giotto Raphael and Michelangelo. <i>Four scenes had been <b>frescoed</b> on the wall.</i>
<b>gouache</b>	A picture painted using the gouache method.
<b>graffiti</b>	Write or draw graffiti on something. <i>He and another artist <b>graffitied</b> an entire train.</i>
<b>graph</b>	Plot upon a graph.
<b>jigsaw</b>	A machine saw with a fine blade enabling it to cut curved lines in a sheet of wood, metal, or plastic. <i>Time is passed by doing <b>jigsaws</b>.</i>
<b>minstrel</b>	Celebrate by singing in the style of minstrels. <i>The exaggerated dialect of blackface <b>minstrels</b>.</i>
<b>moiety</b>	Each of two social or ritual groups into which a people is divided, especially among Australian Aboriginal people and some North American Indians. <i>The enzyme removes the sulphate <b>moiety</b>.</i>
<b>painting</b>	The occupation of a house painter. <i>House <b>painting</b> was the only craft he knew.</i>
<b>partition</b>	The act of dividing or partitioning separation by the creation of a boundary that divides or keeps apart. <i>This takes a copy of hard disk <b>partition</b> information during installation.</i>
<b>photography</b>	The process of producing images of objects on photosensitive surfaces.
<b>picture</b>	Show in or as in a picture. <i>His <b>pictures</b> hang in the Louvre.</i>
<b>sculptor</b>	An artist who makes sculptures.
<b>seascape</b>	A depiction of a seascape.
<b>shard</b>	A piece of broken ceramic, metal, glass, or rock, typically having sharp edges. <i><b>Shards</b> of glass flew in all directions.</i>
<b>snip</b>	The act of clipping or snipping. <i>She was <b>snipping</b> a few dead heads off the roses.</i>
<b>snippet</b>	A small piece of anything (especially a piece that has been snipped off). <i><b>Snippets</b> of information about the war.</i>
<b>sunder</b>	Break apart or in two, using violence. <i>A universe <b>sundered</b> ages ago in a divine war.</i>

**trptych**

A picture or relief carving on three panels, typically hinged together vertically and used as an altarpiece.

A **trptych** on the theme of the holocaust.
