
# Artery as a Noun

- A blood vessel that carries blood from the heart to the body.
- Any of the muscular-walled tubes forming part of the circulation system by which blood (mainly that which has been oxygenated) is conveyed from the heart to all parts of the body.
- A major thoroughfare that bears important traffic.
- An important route in a system of roads, rivers, or railway lines.





# Synonyms of "Artery" as a noun (9 Words)

**arteria** A blood vessel that carries blood from the heart to the body.

**high road** A public secondary school usually including grades 9 through 12.

trunk route Compartment in an automobile that carries luggage or shopping or tools.






Usage Examples of "Artery" as a noun

jugular Of the neck or throat.
