
Artery as a Noun

Definitions of "Artery" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "artery" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A blood vessel that carries blood from the heart to the body.
- Any of the muscular-walled tubes forming part of the circulation system by which blood (mainly that which has been oxygenated) is conveyed from the heart to all parts of the body.
- A major thoroughfare that bears important traffic.
- An important route in a system of roads, rivers, or railway lines.





Synonyms of "Artery" as a noun (9 Words)

arteria A blood vessel that carries blood from the heart to the body.

high road A public secondary school usually including grades 9 through 12.

(chiefly in official use) a public road.

highway

The highway to success.

main line A principal pipe in a system that distributes water or gas or electricity or that

collects sewage.

main road Any very large body of (salt) water.

main route Any very large body of (salt) water.

trunk line The body excluding the head and neck and limbs.

trunk road The main stem of a tree; usually covered with bark; the bole is usually the

part that is commercially useful for lumber.

trunk route Compartment in an automobile that carries luggage or shopping or tools.






Usage Examples of "Artery" as a noun

arterial Denoting an important route in a system of roads, railway lines, or rivers.

bifocal A pair of glasses with bifocal lenses.

bifurcate Divided into two branches or forks.

The road **bifurcate**d.

An internal bodily fluid in invertebates which performs a similar function

to blood in humans and other vertebrates.

bloodstream The blood flowing through the circulatory system.

choking The act of suffocating (someone) by constricting the windpipe.

coronary Obstruction of blood flow in a coronary artery by a blood clot thrombus.

A particular quality or disposition regarded as adversely affecting a

disease person or group of people.

We are suffering from the British **disease** of self deprecation.

embolism Obstruction of an artery, typically by a clot of blood or an air bubble.

Causes of cerebral embolism.

esophagus The passage between the pharynx and the stomach.

hypertension Abnormally high blood pressure.

Take by injection.

Inject the foam and allow it to expand.

jugular Of the neck or throat.

He always goes for the **jugular**.

An open space in a town or city, where people can breathe fresher air.

lung The city had to be given **lung**s in the shape of open spaces squares parks

and gardens.

Relating to lymph or its secretion.

lymphatic

The fluid is drained by the **lymphatic**s and returned to the circulation.

A nasal speech sound.

nasal

A whining nasal voice.



Causing a blockage or obstruction. obstructive

pharyngeal A pharyngeal consonant.
