I **am articling**              We **are articling**  
You **are articling**          You **are articling**  
He/She/It **is articling**    They **are articling**

**Article in Present Perfect Tense**

I **have articulated**              We **have articulated**  
You **have articulated**          You **have articulated**  
He/She/It **has articulated**    They **have articulated**
