actual	Being or existing at the present moment. <i>Actual heroism.</i>
actuality	The state of actually existing objectively. <i>A hope that progressed from possibility to actuality.</i>
actually	As the truth or facts of a situation; really. <i>He actually expected me to be pleased about it.</i>
candidly	In an honest and straightforward way; frankly. <i>He candidly discussed his efforts to find employment.</i>
certainty	A fact that is definitely true or an event that is definitely going to take place. <i>He was expected to be a certainty for a gold medal.</i>
diction	The choice and use of words and phrases in speech or writing. <i>Wordsworth campaigned against exaggerated poetic diction.</i>
equally	In the same manner or to the same extent. <i>They were equally beautiful.</i>
evenly	So as to present a flat or uniform surface or line. <i>The match was evenly balanced throughout the first half.</i>
exact	Inflict (revenge) on someone. <i>Hit the exact center of the target.</i>
fair	Without favoring one party in a fair evenhanded manner. <i>Looks like it s fairing off some.</i>
frankly	It is sincerely the case that (used as intensives reflecting the speaker’s attitude). <i>She talks very frankly about herself.</i>
genuinely	Genuinely with authority. <i>Both parties genuinely believe they re right.</i>

<u>honestly</u>	It is sincerely the case that used as intensives reflecting the speaker's attitude honestly adv in an honest manner. <i>In he can't get it honestly he is willing to steal it.</i>
<u>indeed</u>	Used in a response to express interest, surprise, or contempt. <i>It was not expected to last long and indeed it took less than three weeks.</i>
indistinguishable	Not capable of being distinguished or differentiated. <i>A colorless person quite indistinguishable from the colorless mass of humanity.</i>
integrity	An undivided or unbroken completeness or totality with nothing wanting. <i>Integrity checking.</i>
knowable	Able to be observed, understood, or ascertained. <i>The full extent of the damage isn't knowable in advance.</i>
like	Prefer or wish to do something. <i>I know him him and his like.</i>
literal	A mistake in printed matter resulting from mechanical failures of some kind. <i>A literal solitude like a desert.</i>
<u>possible</u>	The highest possible score especially in a shooting competition. <i>Mickey scored the possible.</i>
<u>qualitative</u>	Of high quality; excellent. <i>Qualitative change.</i>
real	Coinciding with reality. <i>Locke's distinction between the real and nominal essence of substances.</i>
reality	Relating to reality TV. <i>He refuses to face reality.</i>
related	Being connected either logically or causally or by shared characteristics. <i>Income related benefits.</i>
revealing	(of an item of clothing) allowing more of the wearer's body to be seen than is usual. <i>A revealing radio interview.</i>
rightness	According with conscience or morality. <i>The rightness of that move for me.</i>

truth	Conformity to reality or actuality. <i>He thought of answering with the truth but he knew they wouldn't believe it.</i>
<u>veracity</u>	Habitual truthfulness. <i>Voters should be concerned about his veracity and character.</i>
<u>virtual</u>	Existing in essence or effect though not in actual fact. <i>Virtual learning.</i>
wording	The words used to express something; the way in which something is expressed. <i>The standard form of wording for a consent letter.</i>
