Associations of "As if" (30 Words)

alike	In a like manner. <i>He talked in a friendly manner to staff and patients alike.</i>
<u>commensurate</u>	Corresponding in size or degree or extent. <i>Pay should be commensurate with the time worked.</i>
<u>comparable</u>	Able to be likened to another; similar. <i>The situation in Holland is comparable to that in England.</i>
<u>congruent</u>	(of figures) identical in form; coinciding exactly when superimposed. <i>The rules may not be congruent with the requirements of the law.</i>
congruous	In agreement or harmony. <i>This explanation is congruous with earlier observations.</i>
<u>ditto</u>	The same thing again used in lists and accounts and often indicated by a ditto mark under the word or figure to be repeated. <i>If one folds his arms so does the other if one crosses his legs ditto.</i>
equal	Be equal to in quality or ability. <i>Four plus six divided by two equals five.</i>
<u>equalize</u>	Compensate; make the score equal. <i>Morgan equalized ten minutes into the second half.</i>
<u>equally</u>	In equal amounts or shares; in a balanced or impartial way. <i>They were equally beautiful.</i>
equivalent	The atomic weight of an element that has the same combining capacity as a given weight of another element; the standard is 8 for oxygen. <i>The French equivalent of the Bank of England.</i>
evenhanded	Without partiality. <i>Evenhanded justice.</i>
<u>evenly</u>	In a level and regular way. <i>Signals are numbered evenly 2 4 6 8 etc.</i>

fair	Without favoring one party in a fair evenhanded manner. <i>Deal fairly with one another.</i>
identical	(of something encountered on separate occasions) the same. <i>The passage on the second floor was identical to the one below.</i> Not capable of being distinguished or differentiated.
indistinguishable	<i>A colorless person quite indistinguishable from the colorless mass of humanity.</i>
isochronous	Occupying equal time.
just	Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable. <i>I just can't take it anymore.</i>
justice	A public official authorized to decide questions brought before a court of justice. <i>A concern for justice peace and genuine respect for people.</i>
like	A kind of person. <i>I know him him and his like.</i>
liken	Point out the resemblance of someone or something to. <i>Racism is likened to a contagious disease.</i>
par	A par score at a hole. <i>A par 5 hole.</i>
proportionate	Agreeing in amount, magnitude, or degree. <i>Proportionate representation of a minority group.</i>
same	Same in identity. <i>She was saying the same thing over and over.</i>
similar	A person or thing similar to another. <i>He was one of those whose similar you never meet.</i>
similitude	Similarity in appearance or character or nature between persons or things. <i>There is a striking similitude between the brother and sister.</i>
symmetrical	Exhibiting equivalence or correspondence among constituents of an entity or between different entities. <i>The shape of a hill smooth and symmetrical.</i>
synonymous	(of a word or phrase) having the same meaning as another word or phrase in the same language. <i>His deeds had made his name synonymous with victory.</i>
tantamount	Being essentially equal to something. <i>The resignations were tantamount to an admission of guilt.</i>
