alike	In a like manner. <i>He talked in a friendly manner to staff and patients alike.</i>
<u>commensurate</u>	Corresponding in size or degree or extent. Pay should be commensurate with the time worked.
<u>comparable</u>	Able to be likened to another; similar. <i>The situation in Holland is comparable to that in England</i> .
<u>congruent</u>	(of figures) identical in form; coinciding exactly when superimposed. The rules may not be congruent with the requirements of the law.
congruous	In agreement or harmony. This explanation is congruous with earlier observations.
<u>ditto</u>	The same thing again used in lists and accounts and often indicated by a ditto mark under the word or figure to be repeated. If one folds his arms so does the other if one crosses his legs ditto .
equal	Be equal to in quality or ability. Four plus six divided by two equal s five.
<u>equalize</u>	Compensate; make the score equal. Morgan equalize d ten minutes into the second half.
<u>equally</u>	In equal amounts or shares; in a balanced or impartial way. They were equally beautiful.
equivalent	The atomic weight of an element that has the same combining capacity as a given weight of another element; the standard is 8 for oxygen. <i>The French equivalent</i> of the Bank of England.
evenhanded	Without partiality. <i>Evenhanded</i> justice.
<u>evenly</u>	In a level and regular way. Signals are numbered evenly 2 4 6 8 etc.



fair	Without favoring one party in a fair evenhanded manner. Deal fair ly with one another.
<u>identical</u>	(of something encountered on separate occasions) the same. The passage on the second floor was identical to the one below.
indistinguishable	Not capable of being distinguished or differentiated. A colorless person quite indistinguishable from the colorless mass of humanity.
isochronous	Occupying equal time.
<u>just</u>	Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable. I just can t take it anymore.
<u>justice</u>	A public official authorized to decide questions brought before a court of justice. A concern for justice peace and genuine respect for people.
like	A kind of person. I know him him and his like .
liken	Point out the resemblance of someone or something to. <i>Racism is likened to a contagious disease.</i>
par	A par score at a hole. A par 5 hole.
proportionate	Agreeing in amount, magnitude, or degree. Proportionate representation of a minority group.
same	Same in identity. She was saying the same thing over and over.
similar	A person or thing similar to another. He was one of those whose similar you never meet.
similitude	Similarity in appearance or character or nature between persons or things. There is a striking similitude between the brother and sister.
symmetrical	Exhibiting equivalence or correspondence among constituents of an entity or between different entities. The shape of a hill smooth and symmetrical .
synonymous	(of a word or phrase) having the same meaning as another word or phrase in the same language. <i>His deeds had made his name synonymous with victory.</i>
<u>tantamount</u>	Being essentially equal to something. <i>The resignations were tantamount to an admission of guilt.</i>
