## Associations of "As per usual" (30 Words)

<b>accustomed</b>	Commonly used or practiced; usual. <i>His <b>accustomed</b> route.</i>
<b>alike</b>	Used to show that something applies equally to a number of specified subjects. <i>They looked utterly <b>alike</b>.</i>
<b>bland</b>	Lacking stimulating characteristics; uninteresting. <i>A <b>bland</b> and unadventurous vegetarian dish.</i>
<b>bore</b>	A person who evokes boredom. <i><b>Bore</b> a hole in the wall to pass the cable through.</i>
<b>common</b>	Common to or shared by two or more parties. <i>The swordfish is not <b>common</b> in European waters.</i>
<b>consistently</b>	In a fair and impartial way. <i>The vehicle <b>consistently</b> outperforms some of the best competitors.</i>
<b>customary</b>	According to a person's habitual practice. <i>I put the kettle on for our <b>customary</b> cup of coffee.</i>
<b>equally</b>	In addition and having the same importance (used to introduce a further comment). <i>All children should be treated <b>equally</b>.</i>
<b>equivalent</b>	The mass of a particular substance that can combine with or displace one gram of hydrogen or eight grams of oxygen, used in expressing combining powers, especially of elements. <i>Send two dollars or the <b>equivalent</b> in stamps.</i>
<b>evenly</b>	Used to indicate a number that is divisible by two without a remainder. <i>The jackpot will be split <b>evenly</b> among the holders of the three tickets.</i>
<b>featureless</b>	Lacking distinguishing characteristics or features. <i>A <b>featureless</b> landscape of snow and ice.</i>
<b>habitual</b>	Done constantly or as a habit. <i>A <b>habitual</b> late sleeper.</i>

<b>identical</b>	Derived from a single egg or ovum. <i>This is the <b>identical</b> room we stayed in before.</i>
<b>insipid</b>	Lacking taste or flavor or tang. <i>Many artists continued to churn out <b>insipid</b> shallow works.</i>
<b>inveterate</b>	Habitual. <i>His <b>inveterate</b> hostility to what he considered to be the reactionary powers.</i>
<b>lackluster</b>	Lacking luster or shine. <i>A dull <b>lackluster</b> life.</i>
<b>like</b>	In the manner of. <i>A church interior the <b>like</b> of which he had never seen before.</i>
<b>mundane</b>	Found in the ordinary course of events- Anita Diamant. <i>Not a fairy palace yet a <b>mundane</b> wonder of unimagined kind.</i>
<b>nondescript</b>	A nondescript person or thing. <i>The <b>nondescripts</b> were straight out of the nine to five banking bureaucracy.</i>
<b>normal</b>	Conforming with or constituting a norm or standard or level or type or social norm not abnormal. <i><b>Normal</b> diplomatic relations.</i>
<b>ordinary</b>	Not interesting or exceptional; commonplace. <i>He sets out to depict <b>ordinary</b> people.</i>
<b>quotidian</b>	Found in the ordinary course of events- Anita Diamant. <i>There s nothing quite like a real train conductor to add color to a <b>quotidian</b> commute.</i>
<b>regular</b>	A regular patron. <i>His <b>regular</b> calls on his customers.</i>
<b>routine</b>	Organize according to a routine. <i>It was a <b>routine</b> day.</i>
<b>same</b>	Similarly in the same way. <i>Curtains the <b>same</b> color as the walls.</i>
<b>similarity</b>	A similar feature or aspect. <i>The <b>similarity</b> of symptoms makes them hard to diagnose.</i>
<b>tantamount</b>	Being essentially equal to something. <i>The resignations were <b>tantamount</b> to an admission of guilt.</i>
<b>uniformly</b>	In a way that is the same in all cases and at all times. <i>The rules are applied <b>uniformly</b>.</i>
<b>vapid</b>	Offering nothing that is stimulating or challenging; bland. <i>A <b>vapid</b> conversation.</i>
