alike	In a like manner. <i>Parents and teachers alike demanded reforms.</i>
applicable	Relevant or appropriate. <i>Gave applicable examples to support her argument.</i>
comparable	Conforming in every respect. <i>Nobody is comparable with this athlete.</i>
contemporary	Belonging to the present time. <i>The composer Salieri was contemporary with Mozart.</i>
equalize	Make equal, uniform, corresponding, or matching. <i>The purpose is to equalize the workload among tutors.</i>
equally	To the same degree (often followed by `as). <i>They were equally beautiful.</i>
equate	Consider (one thing) to be the same as or equivalent to another. <i>Customers equate their name with quality.</i>
equivalent	Equal in value, amount, function, meaning, etc. <i>The French equivalent of the Bank of England.</i>
evenhanded	Without partiality. <i>Evenhanded justice.</i>
fair	Without favoring one party in a fair evenhanded manner. <i>World fair.</i>
identical	(of twins) developed from a single fertilized ovum, and therefore of the same sex and usually very similar in appearance. <i>Rows of identical houses.</i>
indistinguishable	Not able to be identified as different or distinct. <i>They wore indistinguishable hats.</i>
just	Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable. <i>I just can t take it anymore.</i>

like	Used in speech as a meaningless filler or to signify the speaker's uncertainty about an expression just used. <i>As like as two peas in a pod.</i>
liken	Consider or describe as similar, equal, or analogous. <i>Racism is likened to a contagious disease.</i>
literal	(of a translation) representing the exact words of the original text. <i>His interpretation was rather too literal.</i>
<u>meanwhile</u>	At the same time but in another place. <i>Meanwhile the socialists are running the government.</i>
now	In the historical present; at this point in the narration of a series of past events. <i>They should be back by now.</i>
<u>possible</u>	The highest possible score especially in a shooting competition. <i>The shortest possible route.</i>
recent	Approximately the last 10,000 years. <i>His recent trip to Africa.</i>
recently	At a recent time; not long ago. <i>I recently bought a CD player.</i>
same	Similarly in the same way. <i>They all wore the same clothes.</i>
<u>shortly</u>	At a short distance. <i>To put it shortly.</i>
similar	Resembling or similar having the same or some of the same characteristics often used in combination. <i>They wore similar coats.</i>
<u>simultaneous</u>	Occurring, operating, or done at the same time. <i>A simultaneous withdrawal of troops.</i>
<u>synchronize</u>	Occur at the same time or rate. <i>The clocks synchronize.</i>
<u>tantamount</u>	Equivalent in seriousness to; virtually the same as. <i>His statement was tantamount to an admission of guilt.</i>
<u>thereafter</u>	After that time. <i>It was agreed that the meeting be held annually thereafter.</i>
uniformly	In a way that is the same in all cases and at all times. <i>Water can be applied uniformly to crops using precision irrigation.</i>
<u>while</u>	At the same time meanwhile. <i>We chatted for a while.</i>
