alike	In a like manner. Parents and teachers alike demanded reforms.
applicable	Relevant or appropriate. Gave applicable examples to support her argument.
<u>comparable</u>	Conforming in every respect. Nobody is comparable with this athlete.
<u>contemporary</u>	Belonging to the present time. The composer Salieri was contemporary with Mozart.
<u>equalize</u>	Make equal, uniform, corresponding, or matching. The purpose is to equalize the workload among tutors.
<u>equally</u>	To the same degree (often followed by `as. They were equally beautiful.
<u>equate</u>	Consider (one thing) to be the same as or equivalent to another. <i>Customers</i> equate their name with quality.
equivalent	Equal in value, amount, function, meaning, etc. The French equivalent of the Bank of England.
evenhanded	Without partiality. <i>Evenhanded justice.</i>
fair	Without favoring one party in a fair evenhanded manner. <i>World fair.</i>
<u>identical</u>	(of twins) developed from a single fertilized ovum, and therefore of the same sex and usually very similar in appearance. <i>Rows of identical houses.</i>
indistinguishable	Not able to be identified as different or distinct. They wore indistinguishable hats.
just	Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable. I just can t take it anymore.



like	Used in speech as a meaningless filler or to signify the speaker's uncertainty about an expression just used. <i>As like as two peas in a pod.</i>
liken	Consider or describe as similar, equal, or analogous. <i>Racism is likened to a contagious disease</i> .
literal	(of a translation) representing the exact words of the original text. <i>His interpretation was rather too literal.</i>
<u>meanwhile</u>	At the same time but in another place. <i>Meanwhile</i> the socialists are running the government.
now	In the historical present; at this point in the narration of a series of past events. They should be back by now .
<u>possible</u>	The highest possible score especially in a shooting competition. <i>The shortest</i> possible route.
recent	Approximately the last 10,000 years. <i>His recent trip to Africa.</i>
recently	At a recent time; not long ago. I recently bought a CD player.
same	Similarly in the same way. They all wore the same clothes.
<u>shortly</u>	At a short distance. <i>To put it shortly.</i>
similar	Resembling or similar having the same or some of the same characteristics often used in combination. <i>They wore similar coats.</i>
<u>simultaneous</u>	Occurring, operating, or done at the same time. A simultaneous withdrawal of troops.
<u>synchronize</u>	Occur at the same time or rate. <i>The clocks synchronize</i> .
<u>tantamount</u>	Equivalent in seriousness to; virtually the same as. <i>His statement was tantamount to an admission of guilt.</i>
<u>thereafter</u>	After that time. It was agreed that the meeting be held annually thereafter .
uniformly	In a way that is the same in all cases and at all times. Water can be applied uniformly to crops using precision irrigation.
<u>while</u>	At the same time meanwhile. <i>We chatted for a while</i> .
