## Associations of "As well" (30 Words)

<b>alike</b>	In a like manner. <i>Friends are generally <b>alike</b> in background and taste.</i>
<a href="#"><u>anodyne</u></a>	Capable of relieving pain. <i>An <b>anodyne</b> to the misery she had put him through.</i>
<a href="#"><u>commensurate</u></a>	Corresponding in size or degree or extent. <i>Pay should be <b>commensurate</b> with the time worked.</i>
<a href="#"><u>comparable</u></a>	Of equivalent quality; worthy of comparison. <i>Nobody is <b>comparable</b> with this athlete.</i>
<a href="#"><u>congruent</u></a>	In agreement or harmony. <i>The rules may not be <b>congruent</b> with the requirements of the law.</i>
<a href="#"><u>decent</u></a>	Decently clothed. <i>They would meet again after a <b>decent</b> interval.</i>
<b>directness</b>	The quality of being plain and straightforward. <i>Despite the <b>directness</b> of the route the old road was terribly difficult.</i>
<a href="#"><u>ditto</u></a>	The same thing again used in lists and accounts and often indicated by a ditto mark under the word or figure to be repeated. <i>The next speaker <b>dittoed</b> her argument.</i>
<a href="#"><u>equally</u></a>	In amounts or parts that are the same in size. <i>They were <b>equally</b> beautiful.</i>
<b>equivalent</b>	Equal in value, amount, function, meaning, etc. <i>The French <b>equivalent</b> of the Bank of England.</i>
<b>evenhanded</b>	Without partiality. <i><b>Evenhanded</b> justice.</i>
<a href="#"><u>evenly</u></a>	In equal numbers, amounts, or values. <i>A class <b>evenly</b> divided between girls and boys.</i>
<b>fair</b>	Without favoring one party in a fair evenhanded manner. <i>He did a <b>fair</b> bit of coaching.</i>

<b><u>identical</u></b>	(of twins) developed from a single fertilized ovum, and therefore of the same sex and usually very similar in appearance. <i>An <b>identical</b> proposition.</i>
<b>indistinguishable</b>	Not capable of being distinguished or differentiated. <i>The two specimens are actually different from each other but the differences are almost <b>indistinguishable</b>.</i>
<b><u>just</u></b>	Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable. <i>I ve <b>just</b> seen the local paper.</i>
<b>like</b>	Used to convey a person's reported attitude or feelings in the form of direct speech (whether or not representing an actual quotation). <i>There was this funny smell sort of dusty <b>like</b>.</i>
<b>liken</b>	Point out the resemblance of someone or something to. <i>Racism is <b>likened</b> to a contagious disease.</i>
<b>literal</b>	Absolute (used to emphasize that a strong expression is deliberately chosen to convey one's feelings). <i>A <b>literal</b> depiction of the scene before him.</i>
<b><u>possible</u></b>	The highest possible score especially in a shooting competition. <i>Politics is the art of the <b>possible</b>.</i>
<b><u>prone</u></b>	Lying face downward. <i>A <b>prone</b> position.</i>
<b><u>pushover</u></b>	A person who is easy to overcome or influence. <i>Colonel Moore was benevolent but no <b>pushover</b>.</i>
<b>same</b>	Similarly in the same way. <i>The <b>same</b> rules as before.</i>
<b>similar</b>	A person or thing similar to another. <i>He was one of those whose <b>similar</b> you never meet.</i>
<b>simplicity</b>	A lack of penetration or subtlety. <i>For the sake of <b>simplicity</b> this chapter will concentrate upon one theory.</i>
<b>straightness</b>	(of hair) lack of a tendency to curl.
<b><u>tantamount</u></b>	Being essentially equal to something. <i>The resignations were <b>tantamount</b> to an admission of guilt.</i>
<b>uniformly</b>	In a way that is the same in all cases and at all times. <i>The rules are applied <b>uniformly</b>.</i>
<b><u>while</u></b>	At the same time meanwhile. <i>She retired a little <b>while</b> ago.</i>
