Associations of "As well" (30 Words)

alike	In a like manner. <i>Friends are generally alike in background and taste.</i>
<u>anodyne</u>	Capable of relieving pain. <i>An anodyne to the misery she had put him through.</i>
<u>commensurate</u>	Corresponding in size or degree or extent. <i>Pay should be commensurate with the time worked.</i>
<u>comparable</u>	Of equivalent quality; worthy of comparison. <i>Nobody is comparable with this athlete.</i>
<u>congruent</u>	In agreement or harmony. <i>The rules may not be congruent with the requirements of the law.</i>
<u>decent</u>	Decently clothed. <i>They would meet again after a decent interval.</i>
directness	The quality of being plain and straightforward. <i>Despite the directness of the route the old road was terribly difficult.</i>
<u>ditto</u>	The same thing again used in lists and accounts and often indicated by a ditto mark under the word or figure to be repeated. <i>The next speaker dittoed her argument.</i>
<u>equally</u>	In amounts or parts that are the same in size. <i>They were equally beautiful.</i>
equivalent	Equal in value, amount, function, meaning, etc. <i>The French equivalent of the Bank of England.</i>
evenhanded	Without partiality. <i>Evenhanded justice.</i>
<u>evenly</u>	In equal numbers, amounts, or values. <i>A class evenly divided between girls and boys.</i>
fair	Without favoring one party in a fair evenhanded manner. <i>He did a fair bit of coaching.</i>

<u>identical</u>	(of twins) developed from a single fertilized ovum, and therefore of the same sex and usually very similar in appearance. <i>An identical proposition.</i>
indistinguishable	Not capable of being distinguished or differentiated. <i>The two specimens are actually different from each other but the differences are almost indistinguishable.</i>
<u>just</u>	Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable. <i>I ve just seen the local paper.</i>
like	Used to convey a person's reported attitude or feelings in the form of direct speech (whether or not representing an actual quotation). <i>There was this funny smell sort of dusty like.</i>
liken	Point out the resemblance of someone or something to. <i>Racism is likened to a contagious disease.</i>
literal	Absolute (used to emphasize that a strong expression is deliberately chosen to convey one's feelings). <i>A literal depiction of the scene before him.</i>
<u>possible</u>	The highest possible score especially in a shooting competition. <i>Politics is the art of the possible.</i>
<u>prone</u>	Lying face downward. <i>A prone position.</i>
<u>pushover</u>	A person who is easy to overcome or influence. <i>Colonel Moore was benevolent but no pushover.</i>
same	Similarly in the same way. <i>The same rules as before.</i>
similar	A person or thing similar to another. <i>He was one of those whose similar you never meet.</i>
simplicity	A lack of penetration or subtlety. <i>For the sake of simplicity this chapter will concentrate upon one theory.</i>
straightness	(of hair) lack of a tendency to curl.
<u>tantamount</u>	Being essentially equal to something. <i>The resignations were tantamount to an admission of guilt.</i>
uniformly	In a way that is the same in all cases and at all times. <i>The rules are applied uniformly.</i>
<u>while</u>	At the same time meanwhile. <i>She retired a little while ago.</i>
