Associations of "Ashes" (30 Words)

addiction	Being abnormally tolerant to and dependent on something that is psychologically or physically habit-forming (especially alcohol or narcotic drugs). <i>An addiction to gambling.</i>
addictive	Causing or characterized by addiction. <i>He has an addictive personality.</i>
anthracite	A dark grey colour. <i>The anthracite finish on these cupboard doors.</i>
basalt	The commonest type of solidified lava; a dense dark grey fine-grained igneous rock that is composed chiefly of plagioclase feldspar and pyroxene.
chimney	A chimney stack. <i>A factory chimney.</i>
cigarette	An object similar to a cigarette containing a narcotic or herbal substance.
cinder	A small piece of partly burnt coal or wood that has stopped giving off flames but still has combustible matter in it. <i>A cold hearth full of cinders.</i>
crater	Form a crater in the ground or a planet. <i>Oil prices have cratered by more than 50 per cent.</i>
dope	Carbonated drink flavored with extract from kola nuts dope is a southernism in the United States. <i>The horse was doped before the race.</i>
earthquake	A sudden violent shaking of the ground, typically causing great destruction, as a result of movements within the earth's crust or volcanic action. <i>A political earthquake.</i>
erupt	Erupt or intensify suddenly. <i>Noise erupted from the drawing room.</i>
eruption	A spot, rash, or other mark appearing suddenly on the skin. <i>Irritable skin eruptions.</i>

fire	Start or maintain a fire in. <i>Fire pottery.</i>
flue	A channel for conveying heat. <i>Flue gases.</i>
geologic	Of or relating to or based on geology. <i>Geological formations.</i>
hotspot	A place of significant activity, danger, or violence. <i>They identified eight pollution hotspots at the mouth of the Thames.</i>
igneous	Like or suggestive of fire. <i>Igneous activity.</i>
intoxicant	Causing. <i>Intoxicants and drugs are used by some to escape physical or psychological pain.</i>
lava	Rock that in its molten form as magma issues from volcanos lava is what magma is called when it reaches the surface. <i>Tablelands of lava.</i>
ledge	A window ledge. <i>He heaved himself up over a ledge.</i>
matchbox	A box for holding matches. <i>Her matchbox apartment.</i>
mountain	(often followed by `of') a large number or amount or extent. <i>We set off down the mountain.</i>
nicotine	An alkaloid poison that occurs in tobacco; used in medicine and as an insecticide.
pipe	Play on a pipe. <i>Outside at the back a curlew piped.</i>
smoke	Inhale and exhale the smoke produced by burning a narcotic drug. <i>Do you smoke.</i>
smoker	A person who smokes tobacco regularly. <i>He was tackled on the subject during a company smoker.</i>
smoking	The act of smoking tobacco or other substances. <i>They huddled round his smoking fire in the winter damp.</i>
tobacco	The plant of the nightshade family which yields tobacco native to tropical America It is widely cultivated in warm regions especially in the US and China.
volcanic	(of a feeling or emotion) bursting out or liable to burst out violently. <i>Thick deposits of black volcanic ash.</i>
