## Associations of "Ashes" (30 Words)

<b>addiction</b>	Being abnormally tolerant to and dependent on something that is psychologically or physically habit-forming (especially alcohol or narcotic drugs). <i>An <b>addiction</b> to gambling.</i>
<b>addictive</b>	Causing or characterized by addiction. <i>He has an <b>addictive</b> personality.</i>
<b>anthracite</b>	A dark grey colour. <i>The <b>anthracite</b> finish on these cupboard doors.</i>
<b>basalt</b>	The commonest type of solidified lava; a dense dark grey fine-grained igneous rock that is composed chiefly of plagioclase feldspar and pyroxene.
<b>chimney</b>	A chimney stack. <i>A factory <b>chimney</b>.</i>
<b>cigarette</b>	An object similar to a cigarette containing a narcotic or herbal substance.
<b>cinder</b>	A small piece of partly burnt coal or wood that has stopped giving off flames but still has combustible matter in it. <i>A cold hearth full of <b>cinders</b>.</i>
<b>crater</b>	Form a crater in the ground or a planet. <i>Oil prices have <b>cratered</b> by more than 50 per cent.</i>
<b>dope</b>	Carbonated drink flavored with extract from kola nuts dope is a southernism in the United States. <i>The horse was <b>doped</b> before the race.</i>
<a href="#">earthquake</a>	A sudden violent shaking of the ground, typically causing great destruction, as a result of movements within the earth's crust or volcanic action. <i>A political <b>earthquake</b>.</i>
<a href="#">erupt</a>	Erupt or intensify suddenly. <i>Noise <b>erupted</b> from the drawing room.</i>
<b>eruption</b>	A spot, rash, or other mark appearing suddenly on the skin. <i>Irritable skin <b>eruptions</b>.</i>

<b>fire</b>	Start or maintain a fire in. <i><b>Fire</b> pottery.</i>
<b>flue</b>	A channel for conveying heat. <i><b>Flue</b> gases.</i>
<b>geologic</b>	Of or relating to or based on geology. <i><b>Geological</b> formations.</i>
<b>hotspot</b>	A place of significant activity, danger, or violence. <i>They identified eight pollution <b>hotspots</b> at the mouth of the Thames.</i>
<b>igneous</b>	Like or suggestive of fire. <i><b>Igneous</b> activity.</i>
<b>intoxicant</b>	Causing. <i><b>Intoxicants</b> and drugs are used by some to escape physical or psychological pain.</i>
<b>lava</b>	Rock that in its molten form as magma issues from volcanos lava is what magma is called when it reaches the surface. <i>Tablelands of <b>lava</b>.</i>
<b>ledge</b>	A window ledge. <i>He heaved himself up over a <b>ledge</b>.</i>
<b>matchbox</b>	A box for holding matches. <i>Her <b>matchbox</b> apartment.</i>
<b>mountain</b>	(often followed by `of') a large number or amount or extent. <i>We set off down the <b>mountain</b>.</i>
<b>nicotine</b>	An alkaloid poison that occurs in tobacco; used in medicine and as an insecticide.
<b>pipe</b>	Play on a pipe. <i>Outside at the back a curlew <b>piped</b>.</i>
<b>smoke</b>	Inhale and exhale the smoke produced by burning a narcotic drug. <i>Do you <b>smoke</b>.</i>
<b>smoker</b>	A person who smokes tobacco regularly. <i>He was tackled on the subject during a company <b>smoker</b>.</i>
<b>smoking</b>	The act of smoking tobacco or other substances. <i>They huddled round his <b>smoking</b> fire in the winter damp.</i>
<b>tobacco</b>	The plant of the nightshade family which yields tobacco native to tropical America It is widely cultivated in warm regions especially in the US and China.
<b>volcanic</b>	(of a feeling or emotion) bursting out or liable to burst out violently. <i>Thick deposits of black <b>volcanic</b> ash.</i>
