## Associations of "Aspirational" (30 Words)

<a href="#">aim</a>	Move into a desired direction of discourse. <i>The programme will <b>aim</b> at deepening understanding.</i>
<b>ambition</b>	Have as one's ambition. <i>His <b>ambition</b> is to own his own business.</i>
<a href="#">aspire</a>	Direct one's hopes or ambitions towards achieving something. <i>We never thought that we might <b>aspire</b> to those heights.</i>
<a href="#">covet</a>	Yearn to possess (something, especially something belonging to another). <i>She <b>covets</b> her sister's house.</i>
<a href="#">crave</a>	Feel a powerful desire for (something). <i>Will <b>craved</b> for family life.</i>
<a href="#">craving</a>	An intense desire for some particular thing. <i>A <b>craving</b> for chocolate.</i>
<b>desideratum</b>	Something desired as a necessity. <i>Integrity was a <b>desideratum</b>.</i>
<b>desire</b>	Feel or have a desire for want strongly. <i>He never achieved the status he so <b>desired</b>.</i>
<a href="#">desperation</a>	Desperate recklessness. <i>Courage born of <b>desperation</b>.</i>
<a href="#">dream</a>	Have a daydream indulge in a fantasy. <i>He <b>dreamt</b> a strange scene.</i>
<a href="#">eagerly</a>	In a keenly expectant or interested manner. <i>Fans of the show are <b>eagerly</b> awaiting the new season.</i>
<b>hankering</b>	A strong desire to have or do something. <i>A <b>hankering</b> for family life.</i>
<b>heading</b>	A division of a subject; a class or category. <i>Chapter <b>headings</b>.</i>

<b>homesick</b>	Experiencing a longing for one's home during a period of absence from it. <i>He was <b>homesick</b> for America after five weeks in Europe.</i>
<b>homesickness</b>	A feeling of longing for one's home during a period of absence from it. <i>I lived four years in London without a single pang of <b>homesickness</b>.</i>
<b>inspiration</b>	An act of breathing in; an inhalation. <i>Then I had an <b>inspiration</b>.</i>
<b>intention</b>	(usually plural) the goal with respect to a marriage proposal. <i>Good <b>intentions</b> are not enough.</i>
<b>longing</b>	A yearning desire. <i>Miranda felt a wistful <b>longing</b> for the old days.</i>
<b>objective</b>	The objective case. <i>There is no <b>objective</b> evidence of anything of the kind.</i>
<b>opportunist</b>	Opportunistic. <i>Most burglaries are committed by casual <b>opportunists</b>.</i>
<b>purport</b>	The pervading meaning or tenor. <i>I do not understand the <b>purport</b> of your remarks.</i>
<b>purpose</b>	The quality of being determined to do or achieve something firmness of purpose. <i>The <b>purpose</b> of the meeting is to appoint a trustee.</i>
<b>purposive</b>	Having or showing or acting with a purpose or design. <i>Teaching is a <b>purposive</b> activity.</i>
<b>unquenchable</b>	Impossible to quench. <i><b>Unquenchable</b> thirst.</i>
<b>unrequited</b>	Not returned in kind. <i>He s been pining with <b>unrequited</b> love.</i>
<b>want</b>	Hunt or look for want for a particular reason. <i>I tried to supply his <b>wants</b>.</i>
<b>weariness</b>	Extreme tiredness; fatigue. <i><b>Weariness</b> overcame her after twelve hours and she fell asleep.</i>
<b>wishing</b>	A specific feeling of desire. <i>He was above all <b>wishing</b> and desire.</i>
<b>yearn</b>	Desire strongly or persistently. <i>They <b>yearned</b> to go home.</i>
<b>yearning</b>	Involving or expressing yearning. <i>A <b>yearning</b> hope.</i>
