homesick

He was homesick for America after five weeks in Europe.

homesickness A feeling of longing for one's home during a period of absence from it.

I lived four years in London without a single pang of **homesickness**.

Of a person having an insatiable appetite or desire for something

<u>insatiable</u> especially sex.

So **insatiable** a gourmand as myself.

Feeling or showing an envious resentment of someone or their

jealous achievements, possessions, or perceived advantages.

A **jealous** husband.

long For a long time.

Long ago.

longing A yearning desire.

Miranda felt a wistful **longing** for the old days.

nostalgia

Something done or presented in order to evoke feelings of nostalgia.

An evening of TV **nostalgia**.

starve Have a craving, appetite, or great desire for.

Seven million **starve**d to death.

thirst. Feel the need to drink.

His **thirst** for knowledge was mainly academic.

unquenchable Not able to be quenched.

His enthusiasm was **unquenchable**.

Not returned in kind.

unrequitedUnrequited unanswered love.

want Hunt or look for want for a particular reason.

weariness mental work.
