Infinitely or immeasurably small. A minute inspection of the grounds.
Characterized by extreme care and great effort. <i>He is a gentle painstaking man.</i>
Especially great or intense. The action seems to discriminate against a particular group of companies.
Quietly and steadily persevering especially in detail or exactness. She has been a remarkably steadfast and persevering woman.
Showing great attention to detail or correct behaviour. <i>He was punctilious</i> in providing every amenity for his guests.
Demanding strict attention to rules and procedures. A rigorous teetotaller.
Thoroughly scrutinizing, especially in a disconcerting way. <i>Searching</i> insights.
Marked by care and persistent effort. Sedulous pursuit of legal and moral principles.
Showing great care or attention. <i>His studious absence from public view.</i>
Performed or written with great care and completeness. Officers have made a thorough examination of the wreckage.

<u>meticulous</u>	Showing great attention to detail; very careful and precise. A meticulous craftsman.
moralist	A person who teaches or promotes morality.
<u>painstaking</u>	Done with or employing great care and thoroughness. <i>Painstaking</i> research.
painstakingly	In a fastidious and painstaking manner. The property has been painstakingly restored by its current owners.
plodding	(of a person) thorough and hard-working but lacking in imagination or intelligence. Plodding methodical Ralph Bellamy.
<u>precise</u>	(of ideas, images, representations, expressions) characterized by perfect conformity to fact or truth; strictly correct. <i>A precise measurement.</i>
<u>precision</u>	The quality, condition, or fact of being exact and accurate. A precision instrument.
punctilious	Marked by precise accordance with details. <i>He was punctilious in providing every amenity for his guests.</i>
satisfactorily	In a way that fulfils expectations or needs; acceptably. The matter is considered to be satisfactorily resolved.
<u>scholarly</u>	Having or showing knowledge, learning, or devotion to academic pursuits. <i>A scholarly attitude</i> .
scrupulous	Having scruples; arising from a sense of right and wrong; principled. The research has been carried out with scrupulous attention to detail.
sedulous	Marked by care and persistent effort. Sedulous pursuit of legal and moral principles.
<u>studious</u>	Done deliberately or with a purpose in mind. <i>His studious absence from public view.</i>
successfully	In a way that accomplishes a desired aim or result. The plant operated successfully for seventy years.
<u>tireless</u>	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. <i>A tireless worker.</i>
worker	A member of the working class (not necessarily employed. A red flag with the inscription worker s of the world unite.
working	(of parts of a machine) moving and causing a machine to operate. <i>The ratio of working men to unemployed.</i>
