<b>diligent</b>	Characterized by care and perseverance in carrying out tasks. <i>A <b>diligent</b> detective investigates all clues.</i>
<b>elaborate</b>	Marked by complexity and richness of detail. <i>The <b>elaborate</b> register of the inhabitants prevented tax evasion.</i>
<b>exacting</b>	Making great demands on one's skill, attention, or other resources. <i>An <b>exacting</b> job.</i>
<b>industrious</b>	Working hard to promote an enterprise. <i>An <b>industrious</b> people striving to make their country prosperous.</i>
<b>laborious</b>	Characterized by effort to the point of exhaustion; especially physical effort. <i>Years of <b>laborious</b> training.</i>
<b>meticulous</b>	Showing great attention to detail; very careful and precise. <i><b>Meticulous</b> research.</i>
<b>minute</b>	Infinitely or immeasurably small. <i>A <b>minute</b> inspection of the grounds.</i>
<b>painstaking</b>	Characterized by extreme care and great effort. <i>He is a gentle <b>painstaking</b> man.</i>
<b>particular</b>	Especially great or intense. <i>The action seems to discriminate against a <b>particular</b> group of companies.</i>
<b>persevering</b>	Quietly and steadily persevering especially in detail or exactness. <i>She has been a remarkably steadfast and <b>persevering</b> woman.</i>
<b>punctilious</b>	Showing great attention to detail or correct behaviour. <i>He was <b>punctilious</b> in providing every amenity for his guests.</i>
<b>rigorous</b>	Demanding strict attention to rules and procedures. <i>A <b>rigorous</b> teetotaller.</i>
<b>searching</b>	Thoroughly scrutinizing, especially in a disconcerting way. <i><b>Searching</b> insights.</i>
<b>sedulous</b>	Marked by care and persistent effort. <i><b>Sedulous</b> pursuit of legal and moral principles.</i>
<b>studious</b>	Showing great care or attention. <i>His <b>studious</b> absence from public view.</i>
<b>thorough</b>	Performed or written with great care and completeness. <i>Officers have made a <b>thorough</b> examination of the wreckage.</i>

<b>complete</b>	Complete or carry out. <i>You may find yourself in a position where you have to wait for your purchaser to <b>complete</b> whereas your new home is ready.</i>
<b>conscientious</b>	Guided by or in accordance with conscience or sense of right and wrong. <i>A <b>conscientious</b> man he took his duties very seriously.</i>
<b><u>diligence</u></b>	A diligent effort. <i>Few party members challenge his <b>diligence</b> as an MP.</i>

<b>efficiently</b>	In a well-organized and competent way. <i>They recycle waste cheaply and <b>efficiently</b>.</i>
<b><u>enterprising</u></b>	Marked by imagination, initiative, and readiness to undertake new projects. <i>An <b>enterprising</b> young man likely to go far.</i>
<b>exactitude</b>	The quality of being exact. <i>He writes with <b>exactitude</b> and precision.</i>
<b>exactness</b>	The quality of being exact. <i>He demanded <b>exactness</b> in all details.</i>
<b>hardworking</b>	Characterized by hard work and perseverance.
<b>indefatigable</b>	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. <i>An <b>indefatigable</b> defender of human rights.</i>
<b><u>industrious</u></b>	Diligent and hard-working. <i>An <b>industrious</b> people striving to make their country prosperous.</i>

<b><u>meticulous</u></b>	Showing great attention to detail; very careful and precise. A <b>meticulous</b> craftsman.
<b>moralist</b>	A person who teaches or promotes morality.
<b><u>painstaking</u></b>	Done with or employing great care and thoroughness. <b>Painstaking</b> research.
<b>painstakingly</b>	In a fastidious and painstaking manner. <i>The property has been <b>painstakingly</b> restored by its current owners.</i>
<b>plodding</b>	(of a person) thorough and hard-working but lacking in imagination or intelligence. <b>Plodding</b> methodical Ralph Bellamy.
<b><u>precise</u></b>	(of ideas, images, representations, expressions) characterized by perfect conformity to fact or truth; strictly correct. A <b>precise</b> measurement.
<b><u>precision</u></b>	The quality, condition, or fact of being exact and accurate. A <b>precision</b> instrument.
<b>punctilious</b>	Marked by precise accordance with details. <i>He was <b>punctilious</b> in providing every amenity for his guests.</i>
<b>satisfactorily</b>	In a way that fulfils expectations or needs; acceptably. <i>The matter is considered to be <b>satisfactorily</b> resolved.</i>
<b><u>scholarly</u></b>	Having or showing knowledge, learning, or devotion to academic pursuits. A <b>scholarly</b> attitude.
<b>scrupulous</b>	Having scruples; arising from a sense of right and wrong; principled. <i>The research has been carried out with <b>scrupulous</b> attention to detail.</i>
<b>sedulous</b>	Marked by care and persistent effort. <b>Sedulous</b> pursuit of legal and moral principles.
<b><u>studious</u></b>	Done deliberately or with a purpose in mind. <i>His <b>studious</b> absence from public view.</i>
<b>successfully</b>	In a way that accomplishes a desired aim or result. <i>The plant operated <b>successfully</b> for seventy years.</i>
<b><u>tireless</u></b>	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. A <b>tireless</b> worker.
<b>worker</b>	A member of the working class (not necessarily employed). <i>A red flag with the inscription <b>workers</b> of the world unite.</i>
<b>working</b>	(of parts of a machine) moving and causing a machine to operate. <i>The ratio of <b>working</b> men to unemployed.</i>
