alibi	Exonerate by means of an alibi. <i>Every day he had a new alibi for not getting a job.</i>
applicable	Capable of being applied; having relevance. <i>The same considerations are equally applicable to accident claims.</i>
assured	Characterized by certainty or security. <i>An assured tenancy.</i>
balanced	(of a person or state of mind) having no emotion too strong or too weak; stable. <i>A properly balanced symphony orchestra.</i>
checkpoint	A location whose exact position can be verified visually or electronically, used by pilots to aid navigation.
clampdown	A concerted or harsh attempt to suppress something. <i>A clampdown on crime.</i>
compliance	Acting according to certain accepted standards. <i>The ways in which the state maintains order and compliance.</i>
conformity	Hardened conventionality. <i>Their financial statements are in conformity with generally accepted accounting practices.</i>
consistently	In every case or on every occasion; invariably. <i>Students have to be treated consistently by all staff members.</i>
continued	Without a break in continuity; ongoing. <i>To insure the continued success of the war.</i>
cryptography	The art of writing or solving codes.
equal	Make equal uniform corresponding or matching. <i>The total debits should equal the total credits.</i>
equally	In equal amounts or shares; in a balanced or impartial way. <i>Deal equally with rich and poor.</i>

equity	The value of the shares issued by a company. <i>People who have built up a significant amount of equity in their homes.</i>
evenly	In equal numbers, amounts, or values. <i>The jackpot will be split evenly among the holders of the three tickets.</i>
eyewitness	Be present at an event and see it with one's own eyes. <i>Eyewitness accounts of the London blitz.</i>
guarantee	Provide a guarantee for. <i>We offer a 10 year guarantee against rusting.</i>
importantly	Used to emphasize a significant point. <i>More importantly Weber held that the manifold meaning attached to the event by the social scientist could alter his definition of the concrete event itself.</i>
insure	Secure or protect someone against (a possible contingency). <i>Such changes could insure against further unrest.</i>
proof	Make fabric waterproof. <i>Powerful 132 proof rum.</i>
prove	Prove formally demonstrate by a mathematical formal proof. <i>Firearms proved for black powder should not be used with smokeless ammunition.</i>
regularly	On a habitual basis; usually. <i>The person who regularly cuts your hair.</i>
same	Same in identity. <i>She was saying the same thing over and over.</i>
scan	An image obtained by scanning or with a scanner. <i>A quick scan of the sports page.</i>
security	A department responsible for the security of the institution s property and workers. <i>Job security.</i>
studied	(of a quality or result) achieved or maintained by careful and deliberate effort. <i>A studied smile.</i>
systematically	In a systematic or consistent manner. <i>Villages were systematically destroyed by bombing.</i>
underwrite	Guarantee financial support of. <i>They were willing to underwrite in part the construction of a ship.</i>
uniformly	In a way that is the same in all cases and at all times. <i>The rules are applied uniformly.</i>
