## Associations of "Assuring" (30 Words)

<a href="#">alibi</a>	Exonerate by means of an alibi. <i>Every day he had a new <b>alibi</b> for not getting a job.</i>
<b>applicable</b>	Capable of being applied; having relevance. <i>The same considerations are equally <b>applicable</b> to accident claims.</i>
<b>assured</b>	Characterized by certainty or security. <i>An <b>assured</b> tenancy.</i>
<b>balanced</b>	(of a person or state of mind) having no emotion too strong or too weak; stable. <i>A properly <b>balanced</b> symphony orchestra.</i>
<a href="#">checkpoint</a>	A location whose exact position can be verified visually or electronically, used by pilots to aid navigation.
<b>clampdown</b>	A concerted or harsh attempt to suppress something. <i>A <b>clampdown</b> on crime.</i>
<b>compliance</b>	Acting according to certain accepted standards. <i>The ways in which the state maintains order and <b>compliance</b>.</i>
<a href="#">conformity</a>	Hardened conventionality. <i>Their financial statements are in <b>conformity</b> with generally accepted accounting practices.</i>
<b>consistently</b>	In every case or on every occasion; invariably. <i>Students have to be treated <b>consistently</b> by all staff members.</i>
<b>continued</b>	Without a break in continuity; ongoing. <i>To insure the <b>continued</b> success of the war.</i>
<b>cryptography</b>	The art of writing or solving codes.
<b>equal</b>	Make equal uniform corresponding or matching. <i>The total debits should <b>equal</b> the total credits.</i>
<a href="#">equally</a>	In equal amounts or shares; in a balanced or impartial way. <i>Deal <b>equally</b> with rich and poor.</i>

<b>equity</b>	The value of the shares issued by a company. <i>People who have built up a significant amount of <b>equity</b> in their homes.</i>
<b>evenly</b>	In equal numbers, amounts, or values. <i>The jackpot will be split <b>evenly</b> among the holders of the three tickets.</i>
<b>eyewitness</b>	Be present at an event and see it with one's own eyes. <i><b>Eyewitness</b> accounts of the London blitz.</i>
<b>guarantee</b>	Provide a guarantee for. <i>We offer a 10 year <b>guarantee</b> against rusting.</i>
<b>importantly</b>	Used to emphasize a significant point. <i>More <b>importantly</b> Weber held that the manifold meaning attached to the event by the social scientist could alter his definition of the concrete event itself.</i>
<b>insure</b>	Secure or protect someone against (a possible contingency). <i>Such changes could <b>insure</b> against further unrest.</i>
<b>proof</b>	Make fabric waterproof. <i>Powerful 132 <b>proof</b> rum.</i>
<b>prove</b>	Prove formally demonstrate by a mathematical formal proof. <i>Firearms <b>proved</b> for black powder should not be used with smokeless ammunition.</i>
<b>regularly</b>	On a habitual basis; usually. <i>The person who <b>regularly</b> cuts your hair.</i>
<b>same</b>	Same in identity. <i>She was saying the <b>same</b> thing over and over.</i>
<b>scan</b>	An image obtained by scanning or with a scanner. <i>A quick <b>scan</b> of the sports page.</i>
<b>security</b>	A department responsible for the security of the institution s property and workers. <i>Job <b>security</b>.</i>
<b>studied</b>	(of a quality or result) achieved or maintained by careful and deliberate effort. <i>A <b>studied</b> smile.</i>
<b>systematically</b>	In a systematic or consistent manner. <i>Villages were <b>systematically</b> destroyed by bombing.</i>
<b>underwrite</b>	Guarantee financial support of. <i>They were willing to <b>underwrite</b> in part the construction of a ship.</i>
<b>uniformly</b>	In a way that is the same in all cases and at all times. <i>The rules are applied <b>uniformly</b>.</i>
