miraculously

The two drivers miraculously escaped with only minor injuries.

**prodigious**Far beyond what is usual in magnitude or degree.

The stave consumed a prodicious amount of fields

The stove consumed a **prodigious** amount of fuel.

redoubtable (of a person) formidable, especially as an opponent.

The **redoubtable** ladies.

**shattering** Seemingly loud enough to break something; violently rattling or clattering.

**Shattering** rain striking the windowpanes.

Collect or gather into shocks.

**shock** The home made lighting gave my father a **shock** when he touched the

aquarium.

**shocking** Causing indignation or disgust; offensive.

**Shocking** behaviour.

**staggering** So surprisingly impressive as to stun or overwhelm.

The amount of money required was **staggering**.

Very surprising, astonishing, or remarkable.

**Startling Startling** earthquake shocks.

**stupendous** So great in size or force or extent as to elicit awe.

**Stupendous** demand.

**surprised**Taken unawares or suddenly and feeling wonder or astonishment.

**Surprised** that he remembered my name.

**Surprising** Causing surprise; unexpected.

She earned a **surprising** amount of money.

**surprisingly** In an amazing manner; to everyone's surprise.
