<u>astral</u>	Being or relating to or resembling or emanating from stars. An astral body.
astrologer	Someone who predicts the future by the positions of the planets and sun and Moon. <i>He was advised by</i> astrologer s to delay his departure.
<u>astronomical</u>	(of an amount) extremely large. <i>He wanted an astronomical fee.</i>
astronomy	The branch of science which deals with celestial objects, space, and the physical universe as a whole.



augur	A religious official who interpreted omens to guide public policy. The end of the cold war seemed to augur well.
capricorn	The tenth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about December 22 to January 19.
clairvoyance	The supposed faculty of perceiving things or events in the future or beyond normal sensory contact. She stared at the card as if she could contact its writer by clairvoyance .
<u>constellation</u>	A group of associated or similar people or things. No two patients ever show exactly the same constellation of symptoms.
<u>cosmos</u>	The universe seen as a well-ordered whole. The new gender free intellectual cosmos .
divination	A prediction uttered under divine inspiration. The mediums are hired to perform divination s.
forecaster	A person who predicts or estimates a future event or trend. Economic forecaster s are predicting a downturn.
forecasting	A statement made about the future.
foretell	Indicate, as with a sign or an omen. A seer had foretold that the earl would assume the throne.
horoscope	A prediction of someone's future based on the relative positions of the planets. He gave lectures on astrology and cast horoscope s in his spare time.
libra	The seventh sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about September 23 to October 22.
pisces	A person who is born while the sun is in Pisces.
predict	Make a prediction about tell in advance. It is too early to predict a result.
prediction	The action of predicting something. The prediction of future behaviour.
predictive	Of or relating to prediction; having value for making predictions. <i>The virtual keyboard uses predictive text.</i>
prognostication	A sign of something about to happen. These gloomy prognostication s proved to be unfounded.
<u>prophecy</u>	Knowledge of the future (usually said to be obtained from a divine source. A bleak prophecy of war and ruin.
sidereal	Of or relating to the stars or constellations.



soothsayer	Someone who makes predictions of the future (usually on the basis of special knowledge.
<u>star</u>	Be the star in a performance. <i>His golf destiny was written in the stars.</i>
<u>stellar</u>	Exceptionally good; outstanding. A stellar role.
theosophy	A system of belief based on mystical insight into the nature of God and the soul.
virgo	A person who is born while the sun is in Virgo.
zodiac	Astrology a circular diagram representing the 12 zodiacal constellations and showing their signs.
