<u>precede</u>	Preface or introduce something with. Bill precede d John in the long line of Susan s husbands.
preceding	Of a person who has held and relinquished a position or office. The preceding pages.
predate	Be earlier in time; go back further. Here parish boundaries seem clearly to predate Roman roads.
prefatory	Serving as an introduction; introductory. In his prefatory remarks the author claims that.
prematurely	Before the end of the normal period of gestation. Prematurely grey hair.
previous	Previous convictions a criminal record. The previous occupant of the White House.
