## Associations of "At peace" (30 Words)

<b>calmly</b>	In a sedate manner. <i>People living in the area reacted <b>calmly</b> to the incident.</i>
<b><u>calmness</u></b>	An absence of strong winds or rain. <i>Those who worked with him refer time and again to his <b>calmness</b> under pressure.</i>
<b>cohesion</b>	The state of cohering or sticking together. <i>The work at present lacks <b>cohesion</b>.</i>
<b>composure</b>	Steadiness of mind under stress. <i>He accepted their problems with <b>composure</b> and she with equanimity.</i>
<b><u>concord</u></b>	Arrange the words of a text so as to create a concordance. <i>A <b>concord</b> was to be drawn up.</i>
<b><u>envoy</u></b>	A messenger or representative, especially one on a diplomatic mission. <i>The UN special <b>envoy</b> to Yugoslavia.</i>
<b>equanimity</b>	Steadiness of mind under stress. <i>He accepted their problems with composure and she with <b>equanimity</b>.</i>
<b>gently</b>	With little weight or force. <i>A <b>gently</b> humorous account.</i>
<b><u>hush</u></b>	Be quiet. <i><b>Hush</b> my baby.</i>
<b>mediation</b>	Intervention in a process or relationship; intercession. <i>They are offering sacrifice and <b>mediation</b> between God and man.</i>
<b>nonviolence</b>	Peaceful resistance to a government by fasting or refusing to cooperate.
<b>pacific</b>	The largest ocean in the world. <i>A <b>pacific</b> gesture.</i>
<b>pacification</b>	Actions taken by a government to defeat insurgency. <i>A wonderful skill in the <b>pacification</b> of crying infants.</i>

<b>poise</b>	Be motionless, in suspension. <i>The bird <b>poised</b> for a few moments before it attacked.</i>
<b>quiet</b>	Become quiet or quieter. <i>Molly spoke with <b>quiet</b> confidence.</i>
<b>quietly</b>	With little or no activity or no agitation quiet is a nonstandard variant for quietly. <i>She spoke <b>quietly</b> to the child.</i>
<b>quietness</b>	Absence of noise or bustle; calm. <i>A voice disturbed the <b>quietness</b> of the night.</i>
<b>quietude</b>	A state of stillness, calmness, and quiet in a person or place. <i>It highlights her <b>quietude</b> and wise passivity.</i>
<b>rapprochement</b>	(especially in international affairs) an establishment or resumption of harmonious relations. <i>There were signs of a growing <b>rapprochement</b> between the two countries.</i>
<b>reconciliation</b>	The action of making financial accounts consistent; harmonization. <i>His <b>reconciliation</b> with your uncle.</i>
<b>restful</b>	Affording physical or mental rest. <i>The rooms were cool and <b>restful</b>.</i>
<b>reticence</b>	The quality of being reticent; reserve. <i>The traditional emotional <b>reticence</b> of the British.</i>
<b>secretiveness</b>	Characterized by a lack of openness (especially about one's actions or purposes).
<b>serenity</b>	The state of being calm, peaceful, and untroubled. <i>An oasis of <b>serenity</b> amidst the bustling city.</i>
<b>silent</b>	Not made to sound. <i>A <b>silent</b> house.</i>
<b>softly</b>	Used as a direction in music to be played relatively softly. <i>He whispered <b>softly</b> in my ear.</i>
<b>stealth</b>	(chiefly of aircraft) designed in accordance with technology which makes detection by radar or sonar difficult. <i>A <b>stealth</b> bomber.</i>
<b>stillness</b>	Calmness without winds. <i>An eerie <b>stillness</b> engulfed the camp.</i>
<b>tranquility</b>	An untroubled state; free from disturbances.
<b>tranquillity</b>	An untroubled state; free from disturbances. <i>Passing cars are the only noise that disturbs the <b>tranquillity</b> of rural life.</i>
