avalanche	Engulf or carry off by an avalanche. <i>An avalanche of mud.</i>
averse	(usually followed by `to') strongly opposed. <i>Averse to taking risks.</i>
danger	A dangerous place. <i>He moved out of danger.</i>
dangerous	Able or likely to cause harm or injury. <i>A dangerous criminal.</i>
dare	Defy or challenge (someone) to do something. <i>She dares to dress differently from the others.</i>
dicey	Unpredictable and potentially dangerous. <i>Democracy is a dicey business.</i>
flammability	The quality of being easily ignited and burning rapidly.
forewarn	Warn in advance or beforehand; give an early warning. <i>I forewarned him of the trouble that would arise if he showed up at his ex wife s house.</i>
gamble	Bet (a sum of money). <i>We decided to take a gamble and offer him a place on our staff.</i>
hazardous	Risky; dangerous. <i>Skydiving is a hazardous sport.</i>
imminence	The state or fact of being about to happen. <i>The populace was largely unaware of the imminence of war.</i>
insecure	Not safe from attack. <i>A top model who is notoriously insecure about her looks.</i>
jeopardy	A source of danger; a possibility of incurring loss or misfortune. <i>The whole peace process is in jeopardy.</i>

landslide	An overwhelming majority of votes for one party or candidate in an election. <i>They won by a landslide.</i>
neurotoxin	A poison which acts on the nervous system.
parlous	Greatly or excessively. <i>The General's position was parlous.</i>
peril	Put in a dangerous, disadvantageous, or difficult position. <i>Jonathon perilled his life for love of David.</i>
<u>perilous</u>	Full of danger or risk. <i>A perilous journey south.</i>
perilously	In a dangerous manner. <i>Houses perched perilously on craggy outposts.</i>
<u>pitfall</u>	A covered pit for use as a trap. <i>The pitfalls of buying goods at public auctions.</i>
<u>precarious</u>	Fraught with danger. <i>A precarious truce.</i>
radioactivity	The emission of ionizing radiation or particles caused by the spontaneous disintegration of atomic nuclei. <i>An escape of radioactivity.</i>
radium	The chemical element of atomic number 88, a rare radioactive metal of the alkaline earth series. It was formerly used as a source of radiation for radiotherapy.
<u>risky</u>	Full of the possibility of danger, failure, or loss. <i>Their risky patter made the guests laugh.</i>
stunt	Perform a stunt or stunts. <i>The recovery of our industries is stunted by lack of funds.</i>
threatened	Likely in the near future to become endangered. <i>The spotted owl is a threatened species not yet an endangered one.</i>
<u>toxicity</u>	The quality of being toxic or poisonous. <i>The toxicity of a drug depends on its dosage.</i>
unsafe	Lacking in security or safety. <i>Drinking water in some areas may be unsafe.</i>
venture	Any venturesome undertaking especially one with an uncertain outcome. <i>A joint venture between two aircraft manufacturers.</i>
volatility	Being easily excited. <i>The children have been exposed to the full force of her volatility.</i>
