<u>adhere</u>	Be compatible or in accordance with. They adhere d to their plan.
bonus	Anything that tends to arouse. <i>Big Christmas bonuses.</i>
bush	Vegetation growing in the bush. <i>Bush justice.</i>
dividend	An individual s share of a dividend. Buying a rail pass may still pay dividend s.
<u>drill</u>	Make a hole in something by boring with a drill. The troops were drill ing.
hammer	Beat with or as if with a hammer. <i>Hammer</i> the silver into a bowl.
harpoon	Spear with a harpoon. Gilbert s father harpoon ed a five metre basking shark.
impale	Transfix or pierce with a sharp instrument. <i>Impale</i> a shrimp on a skewer.
<u>income</u>	The financial gain (earned or unearned) accruing over a given period of time. <i>He has a nice home and an adequate</i> income .
<u>invest</u>	Make an investment. Getting workers to invest in private pension funds.
lace	Pass a lace or cord through a hole. A lace collar.
lance	A weapon resembling a lance used in hunting fish or whales. Pain lance d through her.
payment	The action or process of paying someone or something or of being paid. <i>Ask for a discount for payment by cash.</i>



pinch	Irritate as if by a nip pinch or tear. I was pinch ed for dangerous driving last month.
<u>poke</u>	Prod and stir a fire with a poker to make it burn more fiercely. Don t forget to poke holes in the dough to allow steam to escape.
porcupine	A large rodent with defensive spines or quills on the body and tail.
prickle	(of a person) react defensively or angrily to something. <i>The sound made her skin prickle with horror.</i>
prickly	Covered in prickles. Prickly velvet seats.
<u>protrude</u>	Of an animal cause a body part to protrude. When attacking it protrude s its long snout.
shareholder	An owner of shares in a company.
<u>spear</u>	Pierce with a spear. The branch spear ed up into the air.
<u>spike</u>	Render a gun useless by plugging up the vent with a spike. <i>His hair was matted and spiked with blood</i> .
spindle	A Eurasian shrub or small tree with slender toothed leaves and pink capsules containing bright orange seeds Its hard timber was formerly used for making spindles. Chromosomes are distributed by spindles in mitosis and meiosis.
spinous	Shaped like a spine or thorn. The dorsal fin is spinous .
spiny	Having spines. A spiny problem.
stick	Come or be in close contact with stick or hold together and resist separation. <i>Fever left him weak on his sticks.</i>
sticker	An adhesive label or notice, generally printed or illustrated. <i>She s a sticker</i> .
<u>sting</u>	Cause an emotional pain as if by stinging. <i>He felt the stinging of nettles.</i>
<u>thorn</u>	A thorny bush shrub or tree especially a hawthorn. The issue has become a thorn in renewing the peace talks.
transfix	Pierce with a sharp implement or weapon. He was transfix ed by the pain in her face.
