## Associations of "At stake" (30 Words)

<a href="#">adhere</a>	Be compatible or in accordance with. <i>They <b>adhered</b> to their plan.</i>
<b>bonus</b>	Anything that tends to arouse. <i>Big Christmas <b>bonuses</b>.</i>
<b>bush</b>	Vegetation growing in the bush. <i><b>Bush</b> justice.</i>
<b>dividend</b>	An individual s share of a dividend. <i>Buying a rail pass may still pay <b>dividends</b>.</i>
<a href="#">drill</a>	Make a hole in something by boring with a drill. <i>The troops were <b>drilling</b>.</i>
<b>hammer</b>	Beat with or as if with a hammer. <i><b>Hammer</b> the silver into a bowl.</i>
<b>harpoon</b>	Spear with a harpoon. <i>Gilbert s father <b>harpooned</b> a five metre basking shark.</i>
<b>impale</b>	Transfix or pierce with a sharp instrument. <i><b>Impale</b> a shrimp on a skewer.</i>
<a href="#">income</a>	The financial gain (earned or unearned) accruing over a given period of time. <i>He has a nice home and an adequate <b>income</b>.</i>
<a href="#">invest</a>	Make an investment. <i>Getting workers to <b>invest</b> in private pension funds.</i>
<b>lace</b>	Pass a lace or cord through a hole. <i>A <b>lace</b> collar.</i>
<b>lance</b>	A weapon resembling a lance used in hunting fish or whales. <i>Pain <b>lanced</b> through her.</i>
<b>payment</b>	The action or process of paying someone or something or of being paid. <i>Ask for a discount for <b>payment</b> by cash.</i>

<b>pinch</b>	Irritate as if by a nip pinch or tear. <i>I was <b>pinched</b> for dangerous driving last month.</i>
<b>poke</b>	Prod and stir a fire with a poker to make it burn more fiercely. <i>Don t forget to <b>poke</b> holes in the dough to allow steam to escape.</i>
<b>porcupine</b>	A large rodent with defensive spines or quills on the body and tail.
<b>prickle</b>	(of a person) react defensively or angrily to something. <i>The sound made her skin <b>prickle</b> with horror.</i>
<b>prickly</b>	Covered in prickles. <i><b>Prickly</b> velvet seats.</i>
<b>protrude</b>	Of an animal cause a body part to protrude. <i>When attacking it <b>protrudes</b> its long snout.</i>
<b>shareholder</b>	An owner of shares in a company.
<b>spear</b>	Pierce with a spear. <i>The branch <b>speared</b> up into the air.</i>
<b>spike</b>	Render a gun useless by plugging up the vent with a spike. <i>His hair was matted and <b>spiked</b> with blood.</i>
<b>spindle</b>	A Eurasian shrub or small tree with slender toothed leaves and pink capsules containing bright orange seeds Its hard timber was formerly used for making spindles. <i>Chromosomes are distributed by <b>spindles</b> in mitosis and meiosis.</i>
<b>spinous</b>	Shaped like a spine or thorn. <i>The dorsal fin is <b>spinous</b>.</i>
<b>spiny</b>	Having spines. <i>A <b>spiny</b> problem.</i>
<b>stick</b>	Come or be in close contact with stick or hold together and resist separation. <i>Fever left him weak on his <b>sticks</b>.</i>
<b>sticker</b>	An adhesive label or notice, generally printed or illustrated. <i>She s a <b>sticker</b>.</i>
<b>sting</b>	Cause an emotional pain as if by stinging. <i>He felt the <b>stinging</b> of nettles.</i>
<b>thorn</b>	A thorny bush shrub or tree especially a hawthorn. <i>The issue has become a <b>thorn</b> in renewing the peace talks.</i>
<b>transfix</b>	Pierce with a sharp implement or weapon. <i>He was <b>transfixed</b> by the pain in her face.</i>
