### **Definitions of "Atheist" as a noun**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “atheist” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A person who disbelieves or lacks belief in the existence of God or gods.*
- *Someone who denies the existence of god.*
- *Someone who does not believe in the existence of a god.*



## Synonyms of "Atheist" as a noun (13 Words)

<b>agnostic</b>	Someone who is doubtful or noncommittal about something.
<b>disbeliever</b>	A person who refuses to believe something or who lacks religious faith. <i>She intends to prove the <b>disbelievers</b> wrong.</i>
<b>doubter</b>	Someone who is doubtful or noncommittal about something. <i>He had proved all his <b>doubters</b> wrong.</i>
<b>doubting thomas</b>	Uncertainty about the truth or factuality or existence of something.
<b>freethinker</b>	A person who believes that God created the universe and then abandoned it.
<b><u>heathen</u></b>	A person who does not acknowledge your god. <i>A chance of salvation for the <b>heathen</b>.</i>
<b><u>heretic</u></b>	A person who holds unorthodox opinions in any field (not merely religion).
<b>infidel</b>	A person who does not acknowledge your god. <i>A crusade against <b>infidels</b> and heretics.</i>
<b>libertine</b>	A dissolute person; usually a man who is morally unrestrained. <i>His image as an unbridled <b>libertine</b> is a total myth.</i>
<b>nihilist</b>	An advocate of anarchism. <i>It is impossible to argue against a <b>nihilist</b>.</i>

<b>pagan</b>	A person who follows a polytheistic or pre-Christian religion (not a Christian or Muslim or Jew). <i>A Muslim majority had to live in close proximity to large communities of Christians and <b>pagans</b>.</i>
<b>sceptic</b>	A person inclined to question or doubt accepted opinions.
<b>unbeliever</b>	Someone who refuses to believe (as in a divinity).

<b>atheistic</b>	Related to or characterized by or given to atheism. <i>Some were preoccupied with God others were <b>atheistic</b> to the core.</i>
<b>atheistical</b>	Rejecting any belief in gods.

<b>agnostic</b>	Relating to agnostics or agnosticism. <i>Until now I ve been fairly <b>agnostic</b> about electoral reform.</i>
<b>atheism</b>	The doctrine or belief that there is no God.
<b>atheistic</b>	Rejecting any belief in gods. <i>Some were preoccupied with God others were <b>atheistic</b> to the core.</i>

<b>believing</b>	The cognitive process that leads to convictions. <i>Seeing is <b>believing</b>.</i>
<b>bible</b>	The sacred writings of the Christian religions.
<b>deist</b>	Of or relating to deism.
<b><u>disbelief</u></b>	Doubt about the truth of something. <i>Laura shook her head in <b>disbelief</b>.</i>
<b><u>divinity</u></b>	God. <i>A doctor of <b>divinity</b>.</i>
<b>freethinker</b>	A person who rejects accepted opinions, especially those concerning religious belief.
<b>gentile</b>	Relating to or indicating a nation or clan, especially a gens. <i>Christians refer to themselves as <b>gentiles</b>.</i>
<b><u>heathen</u></b>	Relating to heathens. <i>My brother and I were raised as my grandma puts it as <b>heathens</b>.</i>
<b><u>heretic</u></b>	A person believing in or practising religious heresy.
<b>heretical</b>	Holding an opinion at odds with what is generally accepted. <i><b>Heretical</b> beliefs.</i>
<b>heterodox</b>	Characterized by departure from accepted beliefs or standards. <i><b>Heterodox</b> views.</i>
<b><u>idol</u></b>	A material effigy that is worshipped. <i>A soccer <b>idol</b>.</i>
<b>idolater</b>	A person who worships idols.
<b>idolatry</b>	The worship of idols; the worship of images that are not God. <i>We must not allow our <b>idolatry</b> of art to obscure issues of political significance.</i>
<b>infidel</b>	A person who does not acknowledge your god. <i>The <b>infidel</b> foe.</i>
<b>irreligious</b>	Hostile or indifferent to religion. <i>An <b>irreligious</b> man.</i>
<b>monotheism</b>	Belief in a single God.
<b>pagan</b>	Relating to pagans or their beliefs. <i>A Muslim majority had to live in close proximity to large communities of Christians and <b>pagans</b>.</i>
<b>pantheism</b>	Worship that admits or tolerates all gods.
<b>polytheism</b>	Belief in multiple Gods. <i>The <b>polytheism</b> of the ancient Near East.</i>

<b>pray</b>	Address a prayer to God or another deity. <i>I <b>prayed</b> that James wouldn't notice.</i>
<b>proselytize</b>	Convert to another faith or religion. <i>Davis wanted to share his concept and <b>proselytize</b> his ideas.</i>
<b>religion</b>	A strong belief in a supernatural power or powers that control human destiny. <i>Consumerism is the new <b>religion</b>.</i>
<b>skeptic</b>	Someone who habitually doubts accepted beliefs.
<b>staunch</b>	Stop the flow of a liquid. <i>A <b>staunch</b> defender of free speech.</i>
<b>theism</b>	Belief in the existence of a god or gods, specifically of a creator who intervenes in the universe. <i>There are many different forms of <b>theism</b>.</i>
