Attal in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Attal in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have attalled or attaled	We have attalled or attaled
You have attalled or attaled	You have attalled or attaled
He/She/It has attalled or attaled	They have attalled or attaled

Attal in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been attalling or attaling	We have been attalling or attaling
You have been attalling or attaling	You have been attalling or attaling
He/She/It has been attalling or attaling	They have been attalling or attaling

Attal in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I attalled or attaled	We attalled or attaled
You attalled or attaled	You attalled or attaled
He/She/It attalled or attaled	They attalled or attaled

Attal in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was attalling or attaling	We were attalling or attaling
You were attalling or attaling	You were attalling or attaling
He/She/It was attalling or attaling	They were attalling or attaling

Attal in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had attalled or attaled	We had attalled or attaled
You had attalled or attaled	You had attalled or attaled
He/She/It had attalled or attaled They had attalled or attaled	

Attal in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been attalling or attaling	We had been attalling or attaling
You had been attalling or attaling	You had been attalling or attaling
He/She/It had been attalling or attaling	J They had been attalling or attaling

Attal in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will attal	We will attal
You will attal	You will attal
He/She/It will attal	They will attal

Attal in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be attalling or attaling	We will be attalling or attaling
You will be attalling or attaling	You will be attalling or attaling
He/She/It will be attalling or attaling	They will be attalling or attaling

Attal in Future Perfect Tense



Singular	Plural
I will have attalled or attaled	We will have attalled or attaled
You will have attalled or attaled	You will have attalled or attaled
He/She/It will have attalled or attaled	They will have attalled or attaled

Attal in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been attalling or attaling	We will have been attalling or attaling
You will have been attalling or attaling	You will have been attalling or attaling
He/She/It will have been attalling or attaling	They will have been attalling or attaling
