# **The Forms of Attemperate**

Infinitive	to attemperate
Present Tense	attemperate / attemperates
Past Tense	attemperated
Present Participle	attemperating
Past Participle	attemperated

# **Conjugate Attemperate**

#### Attemperate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I attemperate	We attemperate
You attemperate	You <b>attemperate</b>
He/She/It attemperates	They <b>attemperate</b>

### **Attemperate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am attemperating	We are attemperating
You are attemperating	You are attemperating
He/She/It is attemperating	They are attemperating

### **Attemperate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have attemperated	We have attemperated
You have attemperated	You have attemperated
He/She/It has attemperated	They have attemperated

### **Attemperate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been attemperating	We have been attemperating
You have been attemperating	You have been attemperating
He/She/It has been attemperating	They have been attemperating

## Attemperate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I attemperated	We <b>attemperated</b>
You attemperated	You attemperated
He/She/It attemperated	They <b>attemperated</b>

#### **Attemperate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was attemperating	We were attemperating
You were attemperating	You were attemperating
He/She/It was attemperating	They were attemperating

### **Attemperate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had attemperated	We had attemperated
You had attemperated	You had attemperated
He/She/It had attemperated	They had attemperated

### **Attemperate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been attemperating	We had been attemperating
You had been attemperating	You had been attemperating
He/She/It had been attemperating	They had been attemperating

## Attemperate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will attemperate	We will attemperate
You <b>will attemperate</b>	You <b>will attemperate</b>
He/She/It will attemperate	They will attemperate

## **Attemperate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be attemperating	We <b>will be attemperating</b>
You <b>will be attemperating</b>	You will be attemperating
He/She/It will be attemperating	They will be attemperating

#### **Attemperate in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have attemperated	We <b>will have attemperated</b>
You will have attemperated	You will have attemperated
He/She/It will have attemperated	They will have attemperated

## **Attemperate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been attemperating	We will have been attemperating
You <b>will have been attemperating</b>	You will have been attemperating
He/She/It will have been attemperating	They will have been attemperating
