- The action of paying close attention to something.
- The trait of being observant and paying attention.
- The trait of being considerate and thoughtful of others.

heed Paying particular notice (as to children or helpless people. He spends without heed to the consequences.

 $\begin{array}{l} \textbf{regard} \\ \textbf{She had a particular regard for Eliot.} \end{array}$
