Attentiveness as a Noun

Definitions of "Attentiveness" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “attentiveness” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Paying particular notice (as to children or helpless people).*
- *The action of assiduously attending to the comfort or wishes of others; politeness or courtesy.*
- *The action of paying close attention to something.*
- *The trait of being observant and paying attention.*
- *The trait of being considerate and thoughtful of others.*



Synonyms of "Attentiveness" as a noun (2 Words)

heed Paying particular notice (as to children or helpless people).
*He spends without **heed** to the consequences.*

regard The condition of being honored esteemed or respected or well regarded.
*She had a particular **regard** for Eliot.*



Usage Examples of "Attentiveness" as a noun

- *His attentiveness to her wishes.*
- *The past scenes are beautifully handled, with a clear attentiveness to detail.*
- *Mary was particularly touched by Georgina's attentiveness to her during her recovery.*
- *This sight has maintained its top grading due to the attentiveness of the staff.*
- *Half the children who ate the cereal showed no improvement in attentiveness.*
