### **Definitions of "Attractiveness" as a noun**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “attractiveness” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *The quality of being pleasing or appealing to the senses.*
- *(in a person) the quality of being appealing or sexually alluring to look at.*
- *Sexual allure.*
- *The quality of arousing interest; being attractive or something that attracts.*
- *The possession of qualities or features that arouse interest.*



## Synonyms of "Attractiveness" as a noun (1 Word)

**attraction** A characteristic that provides pleasure and attracts.  
*She has very romantic ideas about sexual **attraction**.*

- *Simply smiling can increase your attractiveness to others.*

*An **aesthetically** pleasing landscape.*
- allure** The power to entice or attract through personal charm.  
*Will sponsors really be **allured** by such opportunities.*
- alluring** Highly attractive and able to arouse hope or desire.  
*The town offers **alluring** shops and restaurants.*
- appealing** Able to attract interest or draw favorable attention.  
*An **appealing** look.*

<b>attract</b>	Be attractive to. <i>A campaign to <b>attract</b> more visitors to Shetland.</i>
<b>charm</b>	Induce into action by using one's charm. <i>The trinkets were <b>charms</b> from his wife's bracelet.</i>
<b>charming</b>	Pleasing or delighting. <i>Endowed with <b>charming</b> manners.</i>
<b>chic</b>	Elegance by virtue of being fashionable. <i>The hotel's lobby and restaurant are the height of designer <b>chic</b>.</i>
<b>coquettish</b>	Behaving in such a way as to suggest a playful sexual attraction; flirtatious. <i>A <b>coquettish</b> grin.</i>
<b>delightful</b>	Greatly pleasing or entertaining. <i>A <b>delightful</b> secluded garden.</i>
<b>enchancing</b>	Delightfully charming or attractive. <i><b>Enchancing</b> views.</i>
<b>enthraling</b>	Capturing interest as if by a spell. <i>An <b>enthraling</b> book.</i>
<b>enticing</b>	Highly attractive and able to arouse hope or desire. <i>An <b>enticing</b> prospect.</i>
<b>entrance</b>	An act or instance of entering somewhere. <i>They waited at the <b>entrance</b> to the garden.</i>
<b>entrancing</b>	Capturing interest as if by a spell. <i>An <b>entrancing</b> smile.</i>
<b>fascinating</b>	Capturing interest as if by a spell. <i>A <b>fascinating</b> woman.</i>
<b>glamorize</b>	Interpret romantically. <i>The lyrics <b>glamorize</b> drugs.</i>
<b>glamorous</b>	Attractive or appealing in an exotic or exciting way. <i>I really wanted the <b>glamorous</b> job of a flight attendant.</i>
<b>interesting</b>	Arousing curiosity or interest; holding or catching the attention. <i>It will be very <b>interesting</b> to see what they come up with.</i>
<b>intriguing</b>	Disturbingly provocative. <i>The food is an <b>intriguing</b> combination of German and French.</i>
<b>inviting</b>	Offering the promise of an attractive or enjoyable experience. <i>The sea down there looks so <b>inviting</b>.</i>
<b>irresistible</b>	Too attractive and tempting to be resisted. <i>What happens when an <b>irresistible</b> force meets an immovable object.</i>

- pleasing** Pleasant or agreeable to the senses.  
*A **pleasing** piece of news.*
- salient** Represented as leaping (rampant but leaning forward).  
*The **salient** object in my view.*
- seductive** Tending to entice into a desired action or state.  
*A **seductive** voice.*
- tempting** Very pleasantly inviting.  
*A **tempting** invitation.*
- winsome** Attractive or appealing in a fresh, innocent way.  
*A **winsome** smile.*
