Definitions of "Attractiveness" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “attractiveness” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *The quality of being pleasing or appealing to the senses.*
- *(in a person) the quality of being appealing or sexually alluring to look at.*
- *Sexual allure.*
- *The quality of arousing interest; being attractive or something that attracts.*
- *The possession of qualities or features that arouse interest.*



Synonyms of "Attractiveness" as a noun (1 Word)

attraction A characteristic that provides pleasure and attracts.
*She has very romantic ideas about sexual **attraction**.*

- *This scheme could enhance the attractiveness of the area.*
- *Simply smiling can increase your attractiveness to others.*
- *The new agreements will enhance the city's attractiveness to overseas investors.*

adorable	Lovable especially in a childlike or naive way. <i>I have four adorable Siamese cats.</i>
aesthetically	In a way that gives pleasure through beauty. <i>An aesthetically pleasing landscape.</i>
allure	The power to entice or attract through personal charm. <i>Will sponsors really be allured by such opportunities.</i>
alluring	Highly attractive and able to arouse hope or desire. <i>The town offers alluring shops and restaurants.</i>
appealing	Able to attract interest or draw favorable attention. <i>An appealing look.</i>

attract	Be attractive to. <i>A campaign to attract more visitors to Shetland.</i>
<u>charm</u>	Induce into action by using one's charm. <i>The trinkets were charms from his wife's bracelet.</i>
<u>charming</u>	Pleasing or delighting. <i>Endowed with charming manners.</i>
<u>chic</u>	Elegance by virtue of being fashionable. <i>The hotel's lobby and restaurant are the height of designer chic.</i>
<u>coquettish</u>	Behaving in such a way as to suggest a playful sexual attraction; flirtatious. <i>A coquettish grin.</i>
<u>delightful</u>	Greatly pleasing or entertaining. <i>A delightful secluded garden.</i>
<u>enchancing</u>	Delightfully charming or attractive. <i>Enchancing views.</i>
enthralling	Capturing interest as if by a spell. <i>An enthralling book.</i>
enticing	Highly attractive and able to arouse hope or desire. <i>An enticing prospect.</i>
<u>entrance</u>	An act or instance of entering somewhere. <i>They waited at the entrance to the garden.</i>
<u>entrancing</u>	Capturing interest as if by a spell. <i>An entrancing smile.</i>
<u>fascinating</u>	Capturing interest as if by a spell. <i>A fascinating woman.</i>
glamorize	Interpret romantically. <i>The lyrics glamorize drugs.</i>
glamorous	Attractive or appealing in an exotic or exciting way. <i>I really wanted the glamorous job of a flight attendant.</i>
interesting	Arousing curiosity or interest; holding or catching the attention. <i>It will be very interesting to see what they come up with.</i>
intriguing	Disturbingly provocative. <i>The food is an intriguing combination of German and French.</i>
<u>inviting</u>	Offering the promise of an attractive or enjoyable experience. <i>The sea down there looks so inviting.</i>
<u>irresistible</u>	Too attractive and tempting to be resisted. <i>What happens when an irresistible force meets an immovable object.</i>

pleasing	Pleasant or agreeable to the senses. <i>A pleasing piece of news.</i>
<u>salient</u>	Represented as leaping (rampant but leaning forward). <i>The salient object in my view.</i>
<u>seductive</u>	Tending to entice into a desired action or state. <i>A seductive voice.</i>
<u>tempting</u>	Very pleasantly inviting. <i>A tempting invitation.</i>
winsome	Attractive or appealing in a fresh, innocent way. <i>A winsome smile.</i>
