<b>conference hall</b>	A discussion among participants who have an agreed (serious) topic.
<b><u>hall</u></b>	A college or university building containing living quarters for students. <i><b>Halls</b> of learning.</i>
<b>large public room</b>	A garment size for a large person.
<b>meeting room</b>	A place where things merge or flow together (especially rivers).
<b>theatre</b>	An operating theatre. <i>He was working on <b>theatre</b> defence missiles.</i>

- *The stage was small and the auditorium had only 366 seats.*



## Associations of "Auditorium" (30 Words)

### astride

With the legs stretched far apart.  
*He stood legs **astride**.*

### athlete

A person who is proficient in sports and other forms of physical exercise.  
*He had the broad shouldered build of a natural **athlete**.*

### bench

The politicians occupying a specified bench in Parliament.  
***Bench** the poodles at the dog show.*

### **cafeteria**

A restaurant in which customers serve themselves from a counter and pay before eating.  
*Employers who offer **cafeteria** plans and other flexible programs.*

<b><u>chair</u></b>	The person in charge of a meeting or of an organization used as a neutral alternative to chairman or chairwoman. <i>She <b>chaired</b> the department for many years.</i>
<b><u>classroom</u></b>	A room in a school where lessons take place.
<b><u>couch</u></b>	Treat (a cataract) by pushing the lens of the eye downwards and backwards, out of line with the pupil. <i>There were few problems of double vision in patients who had been <b>couched</b> for cataracts.</i>
<b>crouch</b>	A crouching stance or posture. <i>He <b>crouched</b> down.</i>
<b><u>cushion</u></b>	Soften the effect of an impact on. <i><b>Cushion</b> the blow.</i>
<b>dine</b>	Eat dinner in a restaurant. <i>He has been able to <b>dine</b> out on that story for the last 26 years.</i>
<b><u>dining</u></b>	The act of eating dinner. <i>The city has become a capital of fine <b>dining</b>.</i>
<b>fitness</b>	Fitness to traverse the seas. <i>They had to prove their <b>fitness</b> for the position.</i>
<b>flop</b>	With a flopping sound. <i>This computer can perform a million <b>flops</b> per second.</i>
<b><u>gym</u></b>	A gymnasium. <i>I can't do <b>gym</b> today.</i>
<b>gymnasium</b>	A school in Germany, Scandinavia, or central Europe that prepares pupils for university entrance.
<b>idly</b>	With no particular purpose, reason, or foundation. <i>This is what I always imagined myself doing in the south of France sitting <b>idly</b> drinking coffee watching the people.</i>
<b>incubate</b>	Be developing an infectious disease before symptoms appear. <i>The BSE bug <b>incubates</b> for around three years.</i>
<b>indoor</b>	Relating to sports played indoors. <i><b>Indoor</b> activities for a rainy day.</i>
<b><u>park</u></b>	A lot where cars are parked. <i>They put the car in <b>park</b> and got out.</i>
<b>proscenium</b>	The wall that separates the stage from the auditorium in a modern theater.
<b>recliner</b>	A chair with a reclining back, especially one with an integral footrest.
<b>seat</b>	Place in or on a seat. <i>The mother <b>seated</b> the toddler on the high chair.</i>

- sit** Work or act as a baby sitter.  
*You can **sit** wherever you like.*
- sofa** A long upholstered seat with a back and arms, for two or more people.  
***Sofa** cushions.*
- squat** In gymnastics an exercise involving a squatting movement or action.  
*This **squat** cost the ratepayer 46 000.*
- stool** Grow shoots in the form of stools or tillers.  
*Fibre in the child s diet will soften the **stools**.*
- table** Flat tableland with steep edges.  
*It was a sturdy **table**.*
- tensile** Capable of being drawn out or stretched.  
*A **tensile** steel rod.*
- terrace** Make into terraces as for cultivation.  
*Breakfast is served on the **terrace**.*
- theater** The art of writing and producing plays.  
*He served in the Vietnam **theater** for three years.*
