awl A pointed tool for marking surfaces or for punching small holes.

The cutting part of a drill usually pointed and threaded and is

bit replaceable in a brace or bitstock or drill press.

The act of drilling. boring tool

brace and bit A support that steadies or strengthens something else. bradawl An awl for making small holes for brads or small screws.

The training of soldiers to march (as in ceremonial parades) or to drilling tool

plumber's snake Something long, thin, and flexible that resembles a snake.

A road junction at which traffic streams circularly around a central rotary tool

island.
