- *A large tool similar to an auger, used for boring holes in the ground.*



## Synonyms of "Auger" as a noun (12 Words)

<b>awl</b>	A pointed tool for marking surfaces or for punching small holes.
<b>bit</b>	The cutting part of a drill usually pointed and threaded and is replaceable in a brace or bitstock or drill press. <i>I gave him a <b>bit</b> of my mind.</i>
<b>boring tool</b>	The act of drilling.
<b>brace and bit</b>	A support that steadies or strengthens something else.
<b>bradawl</b>	An awl for making small holes for brads or small screws.
<b>drilling tool</b>	The training of soldiers to march (as in ceremonial parades) or to perform the manual of arms.
<b>gimlet</b>	Hand tool for boring holes.
<b>plumber's snake</b>	Something long, thin, and flexible that resembles a snake.
<b>rotary tool</b>	A road junction at which traffic streams circularly around a central island.
<b>screw auger</b>	A propeller with several angled blades that rotates to push against water or air.

**snake**

A long limbless reptile which has no eyelids a short tail and jaws that are capable of considerable extension Some snakes have a venomous bite.

*The **snake** did not have any provision for strong currency nations to help the weak.*

**wimble**

Hand tool for boring holes.
