Past Tense	australianised
Present Participle	australianising
Past Participle	australianised

# **Conjugate Australianise**

## Australianise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I australianise	We <b>australianise</b>
You <b>australianise</b>	You <b>australianise</b>
He/She/It australianises	They <b>australianise</b>

## Australianise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am australianising	We are australianising
You <b>are australianising</b>	You <b>are australianising</b>
He/She/It is australianising	They <b>are australianising</b>

#### **Australianise in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have australianised	We have australianised
You <b>have australianised</b>	You have australianised
He/She/It has australianised	They have australianised

### **Australianise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been australianising	We have been australianising
You <b>have been australianising</b>	You <b>have been australianising</b>
He/She/It has been australianising	They have been australianising

# Australianise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I australianised	We <b>australianised</b>
You <b>australianised</b>	You <b>australianised</b>
He/She/It australianised	They <b>australianised</b>

#### Australianise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was australianising	We <b>were australianising</b>
You <b>were australianising</b>	You <b>were australianising</b>
He/She/It was australianising	They were australianising

#### **Australianise in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had australianised	We had australianised
You <b>had australianised</b>	You had australianised
He/She/It had australianised	They had australianised

#### **Australianise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been australianising	We <b>had been australianising</b>
You <b>had been australianising</b>	You <b>had been australianising</b>
He/She/It had been australianising	They had been australianising

# Australianise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will australianise	We <b>will australianise</b>
You <b>will australianise</b>	You <b>will australianise</b>
He/She/It will australianise	They <b>will australianise</b>

## Australianise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be australianising	We <b>will be australianising</b>
You <b>will be australianising</b>	You <b>will be australianising</b>
He/She/It will be australianising	They will be australianising

### **Australianise in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have australianised	We will have australianised
You <b>will have australianised</b>	You will have australianised
He/She/It will have australianised	They will have australianised

# Australianise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been australianising	We will have been australianising
You <b>will have been australianising</b>	You <b>will have been australianising</b>
He/She/It will have been australianising	They will have been australianising
