Infinitive	<b>to authorize</b>
Present Tense	<b>authorize / authorizes</b>
Past Tense	<b>authorized</b>
Present Participle	<b>authorizing</b>
Past Participle	<b>authorized</b>

## Conjugate Authorize

**Authorize in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **authorize**                      We **authorize**  
You **authorize**                You **authorize**  
He/She/It **authorizes**    They **authorize**

**Authorize in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am authorizing**                We **are authorizing**  
You **are authorizing**            You **are authorizing**  
He/She/It **is authorizing**    They **are authorizing**

**Authorize in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have authorized**                We **have authorized**  
You **have authorized**            You **have authorized**  
He/She/It **has authorized**    They **have authorized**

**Authorize in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been authorizing**                We **have been authorizing**  
You **have been authorizing**            You **have been authorizing**  
He/She/It **has been authorizing**    They **have been authorizing**

**Authorize in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **authorized**                      We **authorized**  
You **authorized**                You **authorized**  
He/She/It **authorized**    They **authorized**

**Authorize in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I was authorizing</b>	<b>We were authorizing</b>
<b>You were authorizing</b>	<b>You were authorizing</b>
<b>He/She/It was authorizing</b>	<b>They were authorizing</b>

**Authorize in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had authorized</b>	<b>We had authorized</b>
<b>You had authorized</b>	<b>You had authorized</b>
<b>He/She/It had authorized</b>	<b>They had authorized</b>

**Authorize in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been authorizing</b>	<b>We had been authorizing</b>
<b>You had been authorizing</b>	<b>You had been authorizing</b>
<b>He/She/It had been authorizing</b>	<b>They had been authorizing</b>

**Authorize in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will authorize</b>	<b>We will authorize</b>
<b>You will authorize</b>	<b>You will authorize</b>
<b>He/She/It will authorize</b>	<b>They will authorize</b>

**Authorize in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will be authorizing</b>	<b>We will be authorizing</b>
<b>You will be authorizing</b>	<b>You will be authorizing</b>
<b>He/She/It will be authorizing</b>	<b>They will be authorizing</b>

**Authorize in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have authorized**

**We will have authorized**

**You will have authorized**

**You will have authorized**

**He/She/It will have authorized** **They will have authorized**

**Authorize in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been authorizing**

**We will have been authorizing**

**You will have been authorizing**

**You will have been authorizing**

**He/She/It will have been authorizing** **They will have been authorizing**
