Present Participle	aversing
Past Participle	aversed

Conjugate Averse

Averse in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
-----------------	---------------

I averse	We averse
You averse	You averse
He/She/It averses	They averse

Averse in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
-----------------	---------------

I am averting	We are averting
You are averting	You are averting
He/She/It is averting	They are averting

Averse in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
-----------------	---------------

I have aversed	We have aversed
You have aversed	You have aversed
He/She/It has aversed	They have aversed

Averse in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
-----------------	---------------

I have been averting	We have been averting
You have been averting	You have been averting
He/She/It has been averting	They have been averting

Averse in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
-----------------	---------------

I aversed	We aversed
You aversed	You aversed
He/She/It aversed	They aversed

Averse in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was averting We were averting
You were averting You were averting
He/She/It was averting They were averting

Averse in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had averged We had averged
You had averged You had averged
He/She/It had averged They had averged

Averse in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been averting We had been averting
You had been averting You had been averting
He/She/It had been averting They had been averting

Averse in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will averse We will averse
You will averse You will averse
He/She/It will averse They will averse

Averse in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be averting We will be averting
You will be averting You will be averting
He/She/It will be averting They will be averting

Averse in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have aversed

We will have aversed

You will have aversed

You will have aversed

He/She/It will have aversed

They will have aversed

Singular

Plural

I will have been aversing

We will have been aversing

You will have been aversing

You will have been aversing

He/She/It will have been aversing

They will have been aversing
